

## Instructions for Circulating Petitions

You may duplicate these nomination petition pages prior to circulation if the duplicates are exact copies of the originals (8 1/2 x 11" paper, 2-sided, head to head).

1. Nomination petitions may not be circulated earlier than Tuesday February 17, 2026, and no later than Tuesday, March 10, 2026. We request petitions to be mailed to P.O. Box 5169, Harrisburg, PA 17110 to be received no later than Friday, March 6, 2026. If you are mailing more than five petition pages, you will need an additional stamp.
2. All signers must be registered DEMOCRATIC voters, and reside in the county listed on the petition form. Signers must only use blue or black ink pens when filling out a petition. They must fill in their correct name as it appears on the street list and voter registration card, address at which the signer is registered to vote, and date of signing. (Year is optional.) You may carry petition sheets for multiple counties, as long as you make sure each voter signs on the correct page for that voter's county of residence.
3. **DITTO MARKS ARE FORBIDDEN**, and ALL signers must complete the FULL line on their own. DO NOT fill in any part of the petition for the signer and DO NOT MAKE ANY CORRECTIONS. If the signer wishes to make a correction, have them cross out the full line and begin again on a new line.
4. Make sure the signer fills out the date of signing in the last column – NOT their ZIP code.
5. Signers can ONLY SIGN ONE petition for the Office of Governor.
6. The "**Statement of Circulator**" on each nomination petition page must be filled-in and signed after each nomination petition page is circulated. (These pages no longer need to be notarized.) Any person who circulates this nomination petition must be a registered Democratic voter in Pennsylvania.
