🌟 GRASSROOTS ORGS in battleground states. These orgs are doing the hard and critical work of both registering and turning out the voters we need, often including BIPOC, Latinx and/or AAPI voters we don't reach as effectively. [Movement Voter Fund](#) is the best org vetting and funding them. I trust and value them so much that I've got my own fundraising page for them. [That page is here.](#) (Of course you can also just give through their website at movement.vote – it all goes to the same place.)

🌟 If you prefer to give in a more targeted fashion, a great group called Flip the Vote has a fund for one excellent and highly effective grassroots group in each of 7 battleground states. Right now they are giving slightly more of the donations from this fund to Make the Road Nevada, because **they need the funding the most**. 🌟 Blue Tent, a group that vets campaigns, reviews financial disclosures, and tells progressives where to most strategically and effectively give their money, has these three funds. Any of them would be a VERY, VERY good use of your money.
