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1. Create two arrays as shown above.
2. Prompt the user to enter a username and password, and pass these inputs to a method called **checkCredentials**.
3. In the **checkCredentials** method, check if the entered username exists in the **userName** array.
4. If it does, verify whether the entered password matches the corresponding entry in the **password** array.
5. Display an appropriate message based on whether the credentials are valid or not.

public class Mavenproject9 {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        Scanner myObj = new Scanner(System.in);

        String enteredUser = myObj.nextLine();
        String enteredPass = myObj.nextLine();

        boolean myResult = checkCredentials(enteredUser, enteredPass);
        System.out.println(myResult);

    }

    static public boolean checkCredentials(String user, String psw) {
        String[] userName = {"ali", "nijat", "farhad", "aylin", "rufat"};
        String[] userPassword = {"1234", "0987", "4567", "3245", "2344"};

        return true or false;

    }

}
