

How to Log In to ClassLink from School or Home

Step-by-step guide


Use this guide to access your student's ClassLink LaunchPad from any device. You'll need your student's school username and password.

How to Log In (Computer, Chromebook, or Laptop)

- 1) Open Google Chrome or another web browser and login with your **Laurel Google account**.
- 2) Go to: <https://launchpad.classlink.com/laurelpa> You can also access the Classlink Launchpad via the School Links folder in Google Chrome. This is located in the top left corner.
- 3) On the sign-in page, enter your username (without @laurel.k12.pa.us) and your normal school password. - Example: If the email is rlee91@laurel.k12.pa.us, type only 'rlee91' in the username box followed by the password.
- 4) Click the blue Sign In button.

At this time Laurel does not support "Sign in with Google". The QuickCard option will work for students K-2.

Please note: The login does not require the @laurel.k12.pa.us - You only need the first part. Example: rlee - You will then use your normal network password.

After Logging In – LaunchPad

Once signed in, you'll see your LaunchPad dashboard. Here you can:

- Click on apps like Google Classroom, Study Island, IXL, McGraw Hill, and more.
- Use folders (like ES Apps or LSD Items) to find school-specific resources.
- Access everything in one place without needing to retype passwords.

Please note: there are some applications that are only hyperlinks. These applications will still require the student to login.

The following applications are set for single sign on (SSO) and will log the student in automatically when their icon is selected as long as they are logged into their Laurel Google account: **McGraw Hill, Study Island, IXL, HMH ED, Google Classroom, Follet Destiny, Power Library,**



On a Phone or Tablet (iOS/Android)

- 1) Install the 'ClassLink LaunchPad' app from the App Store or Google Play.
- 2) Open the app, search for 'Laurel' and select your district.
- 3) Tap the same sign-in method your school uses and enter credentials.
- 4) Tap a tile to open an app.

Optional: QuickCard (K-2)

If your student uses a ClassLink QuickCard (QR card):

- On a computer: On the LaunchPad login page, click the QuickCard button and allow camera access. - Your teacher will provide the quickcard for your student.
 - On a phone/tablet: In the app, look for 'QuickCard' and allow camera access.
- Then hold the card to the camera to sign in—no typing needed.

Troubleshooting & Help

- Can't find the right portal? **Use: <https://launchpad.classlink.com/laurelpa>**
- Wrong district selected? Click 'Change' and search again.
- Stuck on a blank screen? Close the tab and try again in Chrome.
- App says 'not authorized'? Some apps only work for enrolled students or are hyperlinks.
