Dear WAJSHS Students and Families,

We hope you are all well, enjoying your summer and ready to begin the 2025-26 school year. The purpose of this communication is to give you some basic information for the start of the school year as we prepare for the first day of school on August 21, 2025. Throughout the school year we will continue to send updates and information as needed as they relate to your Wyomissing Area Jr/Sr High School programming.

Daily Schedule:

Arrival to School:

- The Jr/Sr High School will open daily at 7:50 a.m., and we ask that students not arrive prior to 7:50 a.m. to avoid crowds of students at our entrances.
- The two entrances to the building that will be open beginning at 7:50 a.m. are:
 - Main entrance, next to the flagpole on the Cambridge Ave. side of building (Door #1).
 - Door #7; closest to the parking lot near the Evans Ave. side of the building. This is the same entrance that students who ride the bus to school will use.
- Students will report directly to their homerooms on the first day of school, August 21, 2025.

Student Schedules:

- Schedules for the 2025-26 school year will be visible on PowerSchool on Monday, August 11, 2025. Students and parents should log into PowerSchool using the same username and password as last year. If you are unsure of your username or password or have any other log-in issues, please contact Wyomissing Area JSHS Tech Support at wahs-it@wyoarea.org for assistance. The School Counseling Department is not able to answer questions about PowerSchool logins. As you and your student review the 25-26 course schedule, please keep the following in mind:
- Schedule changes are available on a limited basis. Valid reasons to change a schedule would be to switch electives within a given period or to provide better academic balance (such as moving from an AP course to an Honors course).
- Student schedules are based on teacher recommendations, student elective requests, seat availability in courses, and coursework fit within a school day. There are times when requested courses conflict, elective courses fill or elective courses do not run due to low numbers of requests. The school counselors make every effort to accommodate most student requests.
- The school counselors are not able to honor requests to change classes and schedules for certain teachers, to rearrange schedules for students to be with friends, to rearrange course order because of student preference or to be moved to a different lunch period. Please refrain from making these requests as they cannot be accommodated.



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- Students who would like to make a change to an elective course or who notice a problem in the schedule should contact their school counselor **by email** no later than August 15th. Schedule changes requested after August 15th will not be made prior to the first day of school. Students who request changes after August 15th will be asked to follow the schedule in Power School for the first day of school.
