Communicator 1: Affirm teachers from your network or from the national movement we'd like to spotlight that week. [Supportive collateral 1 and 2]	Affirm teachers nationally or from your network.	<u>LINK</u>

Advocate 1: We would like to be part of the effort to recruit and empower educators to be advocates for civic learning that week. [Supportive collateral]	Use our marketing kit to recruit teachers.	<u>LINK</u>
Advocate 2: We want to enlist local, state, or national decision-makers to introduce a resolution supporting civic learning that week. [Supportive collateral]	Work with local, state, and national leaders to promote civic learning.	LINK
