Note : : I'm not including flags because it's harder to organize *in my opinion*, the links are there for a reason. Overall I am **questioning my sexuality attraction**, I'm aware of my relationship and being on the aroace-spectrum. I am going to explain them for your own sake. Highlighted is what I feel most strongly attached to.

Centrisexual □□ where one's sexuality is fluid, flux, and/or has a said preference on the gender they can be attracted to. can vary to one, two, three, or more sexual or romantic experiences to one's attraction; gender affecting their sexuality.

Polyamorous □□ a desire for multiple relationships with one or more people.

Ambiamorous □□ someone who is open to poly and mono relationships with little to no preference.

Poly/Queerplatonic □□ it's a form of a (non)monogamous relationship where someone is capable of having a (queer) platonic relationship with someone/multiple people.

(I included both because one is monogamous and one obviously isn't).

Aroaceflux □□ when someone is both aro and aceflux. Both their sexual and romantic orientation fluctuates but generally stays on the asexual and aromantic spectrums. The fluctuations may occur at the same time or independently.

Demian □□ when someone is both demisexual and demiromantic, i.e in order to have said attraction you need a close, strong, emotional bond with said person.

Apasexual □□ the lack of sexual attraction because the user doesn't and/or cannot care about people. In fact the user does not experience sexual attraction but can still participate in sex, the only difference is that the drive comes from not caring about people.

Nebularomantic □□ someone who has a hard time or cant tell if its romantic attraction due to neurodivergence.

Recipromantic/sexual □□ a romantic/sexual attraction where some doesn't experience said attraction until they know the other individual is romantically/sexually attracted to them.

My most preferred is what I openly say to most people, but I do prefer the labels genderhoarder, kingender, pomogender, and pendogender. [Highlighted is what I feel most strongly attached to.](#)

Transmasc ☐☐ an umbrella term that refers to transgender people who identify with masculinity to a greater extent than other genders; people who generally were not amab and identify predominantly with masculinity.

Interbinary ☐☐ where ones gender identity can overlap sometimes, and differ depending on the situation.

Enboy ☐☐ anyone who identifies as a boy and as nonbinary.

Genderhoarder ☐☐ where one's gender is fluid but one cannot find a single term to describe what their fluid gender is, so they "hoard" various gender terms that fit how they feel.

Kingender ☐☐ an exclusive xenogender where one's gender identity is intertwined with, related to/influenced by or because of kintype.

Miaspec ☐☐ an umbrella term for anyone on the "male" side of viabinary spectrum; anyone whose gender is near male, male aligned or adjacent, boyflux or is similar to in some way that resembles maleness.

Genderspike ☐☐ one is normally given a gender but occasionally experiences sudden and short spikes of a different gender before returning to one's normal "base" gender. The base gender can be any or a combination of genders. And it may or may not be the same gender every time.

Abrogender ☐☐ where one's gender is constantly changing and cannot be pinned down. When someone has so many tiny aspects to one's gender that the individual feels that they are continually discovering it.

Uingender ☐☐ an umbrella term for any genders that are unknown, unnamed, undecided, unsure, undefined, unidentified, unquantifiable, unexplainable, or indeterminate in nature (UIN). It is not the same as questioning, as a uingender individual can be certain in the fact that their gender is unidentifiable or unknowable.

Autogender □□ a xenogender where the only way to describe one's gender is simply as oneself. One's gender can only be described as themselves and is therefore unique to them.

Pendogender □□ the state of never being satisfied with one's gender no matter how well it fits due to self-doubt. This causes one to compulsively search and seek out something that fits even better; to find "the gender" or "the one truth" though one will never be found.

Boyflux □□ in which one experiences varying degrees of masculinity identity.

Contrastgender □□ an umbrella term for those who are multigender or xenogender who have some or all their genders contradict or be opposite with one another. A term often used by gender collectors.

Evenic □□ an individual on the boundary of two existing identities. One might feel like they partly or fully fall under both identities and/or may not identify as either of them individually.

Mutogender □□ its fluidity causes one's gender to change depending on the situation.

Apagender □□ someone who doesn't identify as any particular gender, nor do they care as being seen and/or known as a certain gender; they're fine with passing off as whatever and do not have an opinion towards their own gender.

Transandrogynous □□ a transgender individual who identifies fully or partially as androgyne or other androgynous gender; considered an umbrella term for individuals who transition to an androgynous identity.
