Scholarship Description: The Argyle Rod and Gun Club Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship and is available to students who have been demonstratively involved in organized, competitive Shooting Sports during their school tenure. The Scholarship is available to students who have successfully completed High School and been accepted into secondary education. Both four year and two year / trade curriculums will be considered. Preference will be given to curriculums that produce the basic needs of society and provide a good return on investment for the student. Award decisions will be made by the Argyle Rod and Gun Club Board of Directors. It will be paid upon documentation of successful completion of the first semester and enrolment in the second semester of the program for which the student has applied.

Amount of Scholarship: \$1,000

Who will decide who the scholarship is awarded to?: The Argyle Rod and Gun Club Board of Directors. Applications are due to the address below by April 20.

How will the money be awarded to the student?: Student should provide proof of the first semester's grades and enrollment in the second semester to the Argyle Rod and Gun Club Board at the address below. Upon approval the Board will instruct the Treasurer to pay the student.
