- **If you rented a cap and gown: You may keep the cap, tassel and gown MUST be returned after graduation or on 6/14 (when picking up diploma).**
- **Cap and Gowns cannot be distributed any sooner than 6/10 because senior grades are due the day before. If you would like to get started on your cap decoration, you can create a 9.5in x 9.5in mesh or template that you can glue on top of your cap.**

_____ Check your email for any messages from your college.

_____ Make sure that you have requested your final transcript be sent to the school you will be attending. Final transcripts are usually sent by the first week of July.

_____ If you took Miramar courses (CCAP) make sure you request final transcripts be sent to the college you will be attending in the fall 2022.

_____ If you are “waitlisted” by a college you really want to attend, visit, call and write the admission office to make your interest clear. Ask how you can strengthen your application.

_____ You will most likely get a roommate assignment from your college. Call, write or email to get acquainted in advance. In your conversations and communication, you should be able to figure out who will bring what for your room.

_____ Some colleges will offer a summer orientation/registration. Make sure to attend to meet fellow students and other important people on campus and to familiarize yourself with your new school. This is often the time you sign up for your fall courses.
