

Morning: Temple Sealing Preparation

6:30 am – 8:00 am:

Bride and groom prepare (hair, makeup, getting dressed).

9:00 am:

Bride and groom arrive at the temple for the sealing.

9:30 am:

Guests arrive for the sealing.

10:00 am – 10:30 am:

Temple Sealing Ceremony

The ceremony typically lasts around 30 minutes. Be sure to check specific temple schedules and arrival instructions.

10:30 am – 11:15 am:

Bride and groom change into exit attire (if desired) and prepare for the temple exit.

Mid-Morning: Temple Exit and Photos

11:15 am – 12:00 pm:

Temple Exit and Family Photos

Capture the temple exit, family photos, and bridal party photos.

12:00 pm – 12:45 pm:

Bride & Groom Portraits at the Temple

Afternoon: Lunch Break and Relaxation

1:00 pm – 4:00 pm:

Break for lunch with family and friends and/or relax.

Early Evening: Reception Preparation

4:00 pm:

Travel to the reception venue.

5:00 pm – 6:30 pm:

Arrive at the venue and set up for the reception.

Evening: Reception

6:30 pm – 7:00 pm:

Bride and Groom Arrive at Reception Venue

Bride and groom arrive early for any last-minute photo opportunities at the venue.

7:00 pm – 8:00 pm:

Reception Begins

This may include greeting guests, receiving line, toasts, first dances, cake cutting, and any other special traditions.

8:00 pm – 9:00 pm:

Open Dancing and Final Farewells

Enjoy the final moments of the evening with friends and family, capturing candid moments and celebrating!

9:00 pm:

Bride and Groom Send-Off

(sparklers, bubbles, ribbons, etc.)
