Day 1: Dec 24: Fly to Danang – Overnight stay at Danang

Start your day with a visit to My Khe Beach, one of the most famous beaches in Danang. Enjoy a morning walk along the sandy shore, swim in the ocean, or simply relax and soak up the sun. After a quick beach visit, we can explore the Marble mountain, a cluster of five hills made from limestone and marble in Da Nang. It's also a well-known pilgrimage site with peaks, caves, tunnels and temples all just waiting to be discovered. Named after the elements metal, wood, water, fire and earth, Marble Mountains exist in a coastal area that is renowned for stone-cutting and sculpture. There are also Buddhist sanctuaries and places of worship dotted across the mountains which are a much-visited spiritual site.

In the afternoon, make your way to the Dragon Bridge, a stunning bridge that breathes fire and water on weekend evenings. Even during the day, it's a remarkable sight and a great photo opportunity. At night, explore the markets and enjoy some Vietnamese food.

DAY 2: Dec 25: Full day excursion at Hoi An – Overnight stay at Danang



Hoi An, the historic city, is recognized as an exceptionally well-preserved example of a South-East Asian trading port dating from the 15th to the 19th century. The architectural designs and streets of Hoi An reflect influences of both foreign and indigenous cultures. This unique blend is the reason why UNESCO has also declared Hoi An as a World Heritage Site. The city of Hoi An completely justifies its meaning, 'Peaceful Meeting Place'. Yellow walls, old wooden houses of Chinese merchants, colorful lanterns, small shops, proximity to a lovely beach and a quiet countryside are what describe this peaceful town. This love at first sight city will be our second destination of the trip. After having our breakfast early in the morning we'll start our journey to the **My Son Sanctuary**, which is about an hour ride from the city. My Son sanctuary consists of a bunch of abandoned and partially ruined Hindu temples mainly dedicated to Lord Siva. The temples were believed to be constructed between 4th to 14th century AD by the Champas, who were independent Hindu kings in south and central Vietnam with roots from central Java. Later today we'll explore the **ancient city of Hoi An**. Some other places to visit are the Japanese Covered Bridge, Kim Bong Carpentry Village, Thanh Ha Pottery Village and Vinahouse Craft Village etc.

DAY 3: Dec 26: Full day excursion at BaNa hills – Overnight stay at Danang



A visit to Ba Na Hills, located just outside of Danang, promises a day filled with stunning natural beauty, thrilling attractions, and a taste of European architecture and culture. Start your day by taking the Ba Na Cable Car, one of the longest and highest cable cars in the world, to reach the hill station. Once at the top, explore the Ba Na Hills Fantasy Park, an amusement park with rides and

games for all ages. The French Village is a must-visit, with its charming European architecture, cobblestone streets, and colorful flower beds. You can enjoy a delicious lunch at one of the village's restaurants. Don't forget to visit the Golden Bridge, a unique pedestrian bridge held up by giant stone hands. The bridge offers breathtaking views of the lush surroundings. In the afternoon, take a leisurely stroll through the beautiful gardens and take in the panoramic vistas from the hilltop. Ba Na Hills is known for its cool and misty climate, so be prepared for changing weather. On our way back we explore Linh Ung Pagoda, a tranquil Buddhist temple with a towering white Buddha statue overlooking the hills. Before descending on the cable car, savor a cup of coffee or tea at one of the hill station's cafes with a view. Ba Na Hills offers a unique blend of entertainment, culture, and nature, making it a memorable day trip from Danang.

DAY 04: Dec 27: Full Day city tour at Hanoi (24 Dec 2025) – Overnight stay at Hanoi



Reach Hanoi, the capital of Vietnam, and also its second largest city, is a fascinating blend of East and West, combining traditional Sino-Vietnamese motifs with French flair. It is largely unharmed from the decades of war, and is now going through a building boom, making it a rapidly developing city in Southeast Asia.

Hanoi is full of museums, temples, parks, lakes and wartime sites to see, the most famous includes Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, Lotte observation deck, one pillar pagoda and of course the Imperial Citadel. In

evening we can go for a Vespa Ride zipping through the streets of Hanoi and making intervals to experience Vietnam's eminent street food, culture and vibrant nightlife.

DAY 05:Dec 28 Luxury Cruises:- If you have opted for it (Full board)



Located on the first floor, this room offers a view of the ocean through glass windows. These larger air-conditioned cabins on the second floor come with fully facilities and equipment.

90 odd kilometers from the capital city of Hanoi, Ninh Binh is a small city in the Red River Delta of northern Vietnam. It is a fascinating place where apart from inspiring scenery, you have easy access to the most rural and authentic side of the country. It boasts of the most majestic and spectacular natural landscape in Southeast Asia, called Trang An Landscape Complex. After checking in and having lunch we'll go visit **Thung Nham Bird Sanctuary**. Evening we can spend strolling the market and trying out some local street food.

DAY 7: Dec 30: Explore the wonders of Ninh Binh and transfer to Hanoi in the evening – Overnight stay at Hanoi



Wake up before Sun to go on a hike to the **Mua Caves**. Have breakfast at the hotel after returning and then checkout and visit the gems of the city like **Trang An Landscape Complex**, **Bai Dinh Pagoda** and **Hoa Lu Temple** etc. In the evening we'll get transferred to Hanoi and explore the **Old Quarter** area of the city on foot.

DAY 8: Dec 31: Fly from Hanoi to Reach Ho Chi Min and enjoy the New Year's party here,

Today we will be reaching Ho Chi Min. Time for some last minute shopping as Vietnam is an excellent location for shopping and food. Shall be visiting the Chu chi tunnels where you can fire the real AK 47 riffles as well.

At night, we party hard and celebrate new years in a super grand way till wee hours of the morning.

Day 9: Fly back to our base with happy memories to respective countries or join us for Cambodia (Jan 1)

Part 2: Cambodia - Jan 1 - Jan 4, 2026

Day 1 – Jan 1 2026 : Ho Chi Minh → Phnom Penh – The Royal Charm of Cambodia

Bid farewell to Vietnam and take a morning bus or flight from Ho Chi Minh City to Phnom Penh (6-hour bus or 1-hour flight). After checking in at your riverside hotel, spend the afternoon exploring the Royal Palace and the stunning Silver Pagoda, where Cambodia's regal history shines through. Stroll along the Sisowath Quay by the Mekong River at sunset and enjoy dinner at a lively riverside restaurant. Wrap up the night at a rooftop bar, soaking in Phnom Penh's glowing skyline — a perfect start to the year!

Day 2 – Jan 2: Phnom Penh → Siem Reap – Gateway to Angkor

After breakfast, take a short domestic flight or luxury bus to Siem Reap, home of the legendary Angkor temples. Check into your boutique stay and head straight to Pub Street for lunch and a burst of energy. In the evening, enjoy a sunset at Angkor Wat, watching the golden light reflect off the ancient stones — one of the most breathtaking sights in the world. End your night exploring the lively night market, with massages, street food, and souvenir shopping galore.

Day 3 – Jan 3: Angkor Temples Exploration

Wake up early for an unforgettable Angkor sunrise tour — the kind of scene that stays etched in memory forever. Visit Bayon Temple with its iconic smiling faces, the Ta Prohm Temple (Tomb Raider fame) overgrown with roots, and the grand Angkor Thom complex. Have lunch at a local Cambodian café and spend the afternoon at leisure — perhaps with a visit to the Floating Village of Tonlé Sap or a rejuvenating spa session. In the evening, catch a traditional Apsara dance performance before heading back to your hotel for your final night in Cambodia.

Day 4 – Jan 4: Departure from Siem Reap

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight home or onward journey — carrying with you a heart full of memories from the temples, smiles, and soul of Cambodia.
