



College of Fine Arts & Communication Service-Learning and Volunteer Opportunities

Arkansas Arts Center: Serving as a children's theatre usher, volunteering with museum school events, or filming children's theatre productions

Arkansas Asset Builders: Assisting with community outreach and marketing the availability of free income tax assistance and financial literacy classes

Arkansas Citizens Climate League: Raising awareness, participating in advocacy, and planning and marketing an annual statewide event

Child Care Aware of North Central Arkansas: Creating music or arts-related curriculum for topic bags for early childhood education providers; creating flyers and assisting with communication with childcare providers in Central Arkansas

Children's Advocacy Alliance: Assisting with special events, marketing, social media, and promotional videos to raise awareness about the services provided to children involved in abuse and neglect cases

Compass Academy: Offering enrichment programming at a private school for children with special needs in topics such as music, art, or other special interest areas

Conway Alliance for the Arts: Hosting a hands-on arts activity at Conway ArtsFest in October

Conway Symphony Orchestra: Assisting with marketing/social media/promotional film, ushering performances, hands-on activities for February performance

Faulkner County Library: Assisting with special events such as the Author Fair, Tales from the South, and ComiCon-way; using the library as a site for hosting performances, classes for the public, and any other community event

Independent Living Services: Planning events for adults with disabilities for a Friday afternoon, or participating in planned events (parties, social events); photography at events for annual reports and marketing publications

LISA Academy North Elementary School: Facilitating an after-school enrichment club in arts, theatre, and any other special interests

Literacy Action of Central Arkansas: Tutor ESL and adult literacy; service-learning projects could include leading a focused series (e.g., math education, financial literacy, soft skills), translating materials, recruiting, planning a tutor and/or student appreciation event; host a class; marketing, publicity, and social media

Milestones: Providing social media support for an inclusive childcare facility serving children with special needs; reading to children or facilitating one-time arts programming; supporting social media and website

Museum of Discovery: Ongoing volunteering or participating with STEAM activities in Tinkerfest, held every september

Sunrise Riders: Supporting equine therapy program through communications, such as developing a website or newsletter

Syrian Emergency Task Force: Creating a documentary film using existing footage from Syria, managing Letters of Hope for Syria project
