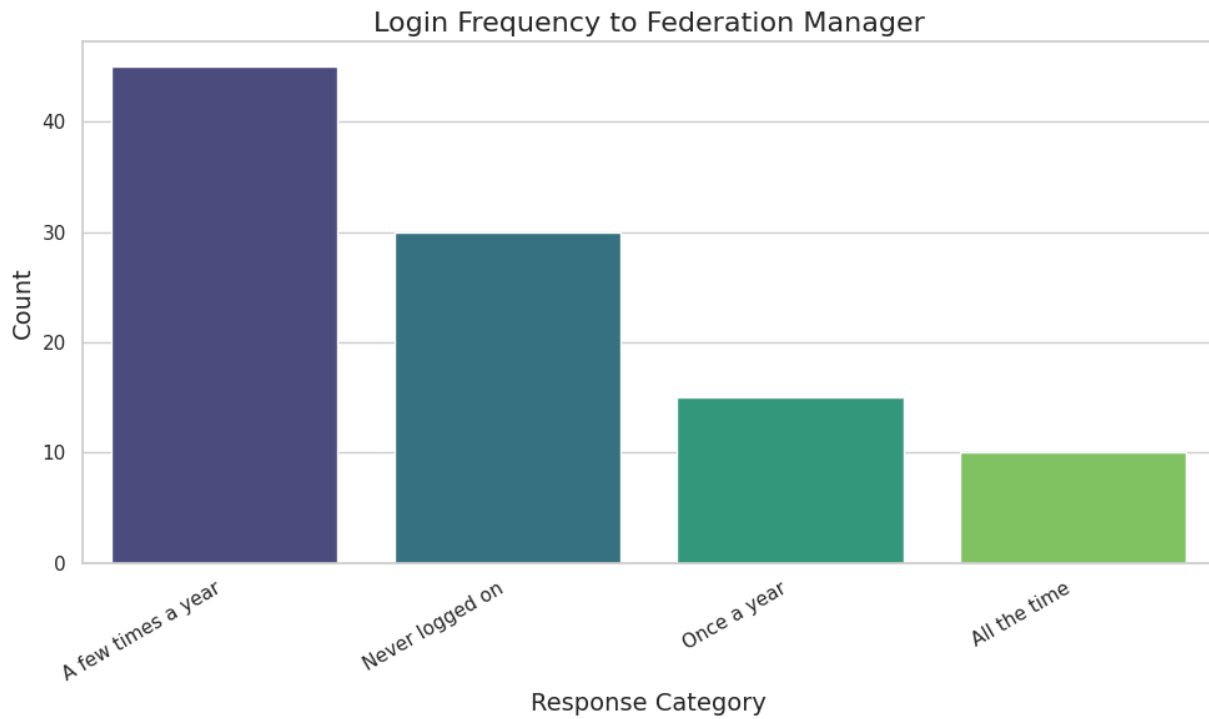
Have you used eduroam when you travel?
