



Royal Statement VI: Regarding Demands towards Faltree, and Those Under its Influence

In recent months, Faltree, once a menace to the Prime Minister and now a threat to Nicene allies and occasionally a threat to the Basileia herself through means of concentrated harassment, has expanded its power and influence throughout the Long Island sector. The recent war with Malus proves that Faltree is willing to do whatever it takes to bring about its hegemony, to such an extent that it is willing to break the rules-based national order.

We cannot allow Faltree to continue as is, and as such, demand the following from Faltree and Malus:

1. The immediate resignation of Owen Bean from all his positions within Faltree, to be replaced in an election monitored by Long Island sector nations as well as outside observers within the LIN;
2. Either the transfer of the Malusian presidency to Andrew Perdomo, to be ruled in personal union with the Kingdom of Ponchartrain-Maurepas (henceforth referred to as the Kingdom of Pontunia), or the submission of the Malusian state to the Kingdom of Pontunia as a direct vassal following all commands given to it by King Andrew I Perdomo;
3. The cession of the occupied territory of Chepiwanoxet to the Roscami Federation;
4. An immediate apology by Hunt Powell and the Micronational Assembly to Daniel Maloney;
5. The creation of an occupation zone within Breuckelen, to be ceded back to Faltree when it has been deemed that they are no longer a threat.

If these demands are not complied with within sixty (60) days, or if they are treated with disdain, several PMCs will be hired to invade the territories of Faltree and Malus.
