Available for Purchase until October 9, 2026

Assurance dates are effective from the second Friday of October to the second Friday of October the following year.

The Chromebook Assurance Program provides an inexpensive solution for families to lessen the financial burden if an accident or theft occurs. The annual assurance is not mandatory but is highly recommended.

Lack of action prior to October 9, 2026, will be considered an opt-out and the student will be responsible for any damage.

New & Returning Students:

- There is a **\$20 fee** for the school year to **opt in** to the annual assurance program. Fees must be paid prior to the **second Friday in October**. If you've qualified for free or reduced lunches this school year and completed the Laserfiche form, you will automatically be provided assurance.
- **Assurance effective dates** are from the second Friday of October to the second Friday of October the following year.
- **Opting out of the program** means families will be held financially responsible for the full cost of repair or replacement associated with any damaged, lost, or stolen equipment. A fine will be placed on student accounts for the cost of replacing or repairing the equipment. Fines must be paid before a replacement device is issued.
- **Lack of action prior to the second Thursday in October will be considered an opt-out.**
- *Please review the details of the assurance program in the table below.*
- If a family leaves the district but does not return the Chromebook, they will be fined the full replacement cost of \$150, and standard rules for restricting records and transcripts will apply.

OPT-IN to Assurance Program

Fee: \$20 **annual** fee per student (nonrefundable). *Scholarship requests available at your fee window. Cut off date to Opt-in is the second Thursday in October.*

Covered: The first **two** accidental damages are \$0.00. After **two** accidental damages, parent/guardian will be responsible for the cost of repair. Loaner devices available during repair.

Partially Covered:

Lost Device: 1st Incident: \$75 2nd Incident: \$150

Stolen Devices: *Must file a report with a School Resource Officer (SRO) within 2 days.* 1st Incident: \$75 2nd Incident: \$150

If the device is later recovered and in working condition, the fine will be refunded.

NOT Covered:

Intentional Damage-such as objects inserted into the headphone jack
Vandalism & Neglect-such as carvings, stickers, writing, removing keys or left in vehicles.

The lost charger fee is \$25

OPT-OUT of Assurance Program

Fee: \$0. *Lack of action prior to the second Thursday in October will be considered an opt-out.*

Damage Fees:

\$25- Charger.

\$50- LCD Screen, Keyboard, Touchpad, Broken Hinges, or Bezel.

\$75- Charging Port, USB Port, Broken Headphone Jack.

\$150- Full Replacement for Instances Such as Lost, Stolen Vandalized, or Damaged Beyond Repair.

- *If lost or stolen devices are later recovered and in working condition, the fine will be refunded.*
- *There are no loaner devices available for students who forget to bring their devices.*
