Baseline Concussion Testing

NEW! Optional Concussion Baseline Testing - Byron will be conducting voluntary baseline concussion testing for all interested athletes. Testing will take place on July 29, 2024 from 8:00 am to Noon in the Byron High School MPR. The cost for concussion baseline testing is \$15 and must be paid at time of testing via cash or check to Mayo Clinic. Parents will receive a message closer to concussion testing with the link to a survey.

Byron Public Schools is finding it difficult to hire and retain certain positions within our school district. One of these positions is transportation drivers. We are able to maintain our routes to and from school, but we are not able to transport athletes to practices and home games that are played off site.
