Major Objective:

Enriching the lives of the dogs in our care by providing mental and physical exercise. Dogs who don't get enough physical and mental exercise are at risk of new behavior problems arising.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Taking dogs within your skill level out to the yard or on a walk.
- 2. Work on basic training, like praising a dog when they go to the bathroom outside.
- 3. Incorporate more advanced training techniques as you progress through levels.
- 4. Sitting with/reading to/training dogs within your level in their kennel.

Qualifications:

- 1. Basic understanding of canine body language
- 2. Must be at least 16 years of age or 12-15 with a parent or guardian.
- 3. Critical thinking skills to determine how best to interact with individual animals
- 4. Level or strength and athleticism

Training:

- 2. Advanced classes and trainings to progress as required
- 3. Recommended reading when shared
