When do I need to apply?

You must submit your completed application by **December 15, 2025** so that the financial aid committee can review your application, determine awards, and prepare for re-enrollment contracts to be issued in early 2026.

How does Clarity make it easier for me to apply for financial aid?

Clarity offers a streamlined, mobile friendly application that can be completed in as short a time as 20 minutes. Additionally, Clarity removes the need to upload your 2024 W2 and 1040 by transferring them directly from the IRS. This reduces the amount of information that you will need to enter manually and makes it possible to complete the application quickly and efficiently.

Is my information secure with Clarity?

Chapel Hill-Chauncy Hall takes the privacy and security of your personal information very seriously. Clarity is certified for both GDPR and SOC2 and uses enterprise-level security standards including end-to-end encryption of all personally identifiable information. Will I still need to apply every year?

Yes, although you do not need to submit a school application each year, you will need to submit a Clarity application each year in order to qualify for financial aid; however, Clarity retains your information from previous applications, so it will be even easier to reapply.

I live outside the United States, can I still apply for financial aid through Clarity?

Yes, all families must fill out the Clarity application to the best of their ability including the Non-US Tax Filer Verification upload.
