Reflection and Analysis

Lesson Content - The content is designed to be open, and of high interest to the learners.

Lesson Pacing - Learners and families can work at their own pace to complete the learning. They can do as many or as little as they like. Tasks are there to provide ideas if they are bored or want to keep learning. Each task can take as little as 5mins or much longer.

Lesson Delivery - I believe the videos add to the delivery greatly at this age group. Taking the pressure off others to explain the tasks. I would love for more face-face delivery but we will see how this goes as we enter term 2.

Student Understanding- The blogs have shown a good level of student understanding. The kids have each taken tasks in a different way and responded as themselves which is awesome.
