## The Angels Verse 4

In the time of Noah a group of fallen and especially evil angels cohabited with women, producing a demon hybrid/ Genesis 6:1-4; Jude 6; I Peter 3:19-20
The fallen angels were <u>punished</u> by being cast into tarturus/hell, a word in Judaism referring to a prison for fallen angels until their
The Ancient World Verse 5
Verse 5 repeats the phrase that God "didn't spare" the judgment of the ungodly, emphasizing a sentence of rather than for all who sin and have not sought forgiveness.
The entire human race was judged except for Noah and seven others who were guarded and preserved from disaster because of his preaching and living a life of righteousness (proclaiming the righteous or just conduct that conforms to the
Sodom and Gomorrah Verses 6-8
God's destruction of these cities to ashes is the of God's coming utter destruction of the ungodly. Jude 7
Fire rained down on all the people except for the righteous Lot, who was distressed and by the lawless deeds that were the daily way of life in his city.
"For If God , Then The Lord " Our Response Verses 4&9
The apostle Peter reveals that if God can rescue Noah and Lot from God's wrath and judgment, He will also rescue the godly from trials ( situations that are difficult and could lead to)
