I would like to ask for your assistance as we begin our Integrated Behavioral Health Initiative quality improvement efforts. The patients we are looking for to partner with will be those who share the same qualities of the patients we believe will benefit a great deal from our initial efforts. Of course, we believe all our patients could benefit from these new health services but at first, we will focus on improving care for members of our patient population who live with <u>chronic co-occurring complex conditions</u>. Therefore, we will be seeking PPs who match these same interests and reflect these same goals by being patients or home care partners/family members of patients who manage these types of conditions.

I've included more information for you to understand more about the specifics of the IBHPC Initiative Patient Partner. (please see attached documents). Once we have identified these PPs we will hold 1-1 conversations with each of them to gain their insight and feedback on the changes we are planning. If possible, we hope to invite at least two PPs to join the IBHPC Initiative as full members of the team to participate in all activities alongside of us while we plan, design and implement those changes. We plan on paying our PPs fairly for their time and effort to establish commitment and to demonstrate our respect for the value that their presence will contribute to the team.
