

Game Warfare Act

Preamble

Whereas: Participating in meme warfare comes with a risk of being banned for brigading.

Whereas: Warfare between subreddits is a fun activity that should be preserved in some form.

Whereas: Requiring the military to assist executive departments does not make sense, as soldiers can simply join those departments.

Article 1: Military Structure

§1. The SimDemocracy military will be led by the General.

§1.1. The General will be appointed by the President and confirmed by the Senate with a 2/3rds majority vote.

§2. The General will have primary responsibility for running the military.

§2.1. The General will recruit soldiers to and dismiss soldiers from the military.

§2.2. The General will organize the military in a manner appropriate for the type of warfare it is engaging in.

§3. The General must follow orders given by the President, as well as orders passed as resolutions by the Senate.

§4. All members of the military besides the General will be considered soldiers.

§5. Soldiers participating in a war must follow orders given by the General.

Article 2: Responsibilities

§1. The military is responsible for conducting game warfare on behalf of SimDemocracy.

§1.1. The military is forbidden from conducting meme warfare.

§2. Before each war, every soldier is responsible for deciding whether or not they will participate.

§2.1. Soldiers may not participate if they cannot access the game in which the war is being fought.

§3. The military is responsible for following SimDemocracy law and all international agreements to which SimDemocracy is a party.

§3.1. If any order violates SimDemocracy law or an international agreement to which SimDemocracy is a party, that order shall be considered to be null and void.

§4. The military shall not have any responsibilities beyond the above.

§4.1. If any order does not fall under at least one of the above responsibilities, that order shall be considered to be null and void.

Article 3: Discord Channels

§1. The SimDemocracy Discord will have a War category with a channel for communication between soldiers and the General.

§2. The General may request the creation or deletion of additional Discord channels in this category, as is necessary to facilitate their command style or create an effective structure for a given war.

Article 4: Repeals

§1. The SimDemocracy Military Act is repealed.
