As a class, we determined the expectations for each Mustang Manner. We agree to follow these guidelines:

MANNERS	STUDENT EXPECTATIONS	TEACHER EXPECTATIONS
Be SAFE	• Treat all items in the classroom with respect (no throwing, damaging, or breaking) • Keep our hands and feet to ourselves (no running, climbing, fighting) • Keep everything in the classroom clean and sanitized	• Give friendly reminders and follow up with consequences for repeated behaviors. • Provide cleaning supplies.
Be RESPECTFUL	• Listen to and look at the person talking, stay on task, no side conversations (classmates and teacher) • Only touch your own stuff and take care of it (return things to their owners) • Treat classmates and teacher nicely, respectfully, compliment their work, and realize that people have different ideas and opinions (no insults, use your manners, include others, MYOB)	• Address these behaviors by speaking with students privately. • Move students who are not focused or listening. • NO drama or saying mean things to classmates will be tolerated.
Be READY	• Use your class schedule to make sure you have all of your supplies needed • Sharpen pencils in the beginning and end of the day • Be on time and transition quickly	• Friendly reminders about what is next on the schedule
Be RESPONSIBLE	• Use technology appropriately and as instructed by the teacher. Take care of your iPad (plug it in, no eating/drinking around it) • Put away classroom supplies (chairs, books, and individual supplies)	• Friendly reminders • Have students organize supplies during recess (if it gets really bad)

Use **appropriate classroom voice level**. Levels 0-3 may be used inside the classroom depending on the activity.

Voice Level 0 = Silent

Voice Level 1 = Whisper

Voice level 2 = Normal Voice

Voice Level 3 = Group Work Voice
