WILF: "Do you know, I remember when you were about six years old. Your mother said no holiday this year. So off you toddled all on your own and you got on a bus to Strathclyde. Ha! We had the police after you and everything"

And sometimes it just takes one random little line like that for my brain to turn on. So here is a possible plot)

Summary- Six year old Donna Noble is running away since her family isn't going on holiday this year. But what if she met a rather odd someone on her way?

Exposition: We start out with Donna and the Noble family at home. Maybe describe their day, I can see Sylvia being the kind of parent that would try and pack Donna's schedule after school with loads of extra activities. Even when she's around six. Fortunately for Donna, it's summer and she gets a break for a while. And her family usually goes on holiday (probably to the beach). She goes to ask her mum and Dad when they are

going and she's so excited only for Sylvia to directly tell her they can't go this year. Something happened (maybe can't afford it right now).

Inciting Incident- This gets Donna mad! She goes to her room to sulk and brood and just be mad at the whole thing. But she gets an idea: if her mum and dad won't go, she'll have her own holiday. And starts to pack her suitcase and toddle off to the bus.

Rising Action- Donna packs everything she's going to need: a few clothes, toys, a book, etc. And waits for the bus. She really doesn't know or care where she's going. It's only when they stop it's revealed she went as far as Strathclyde (which a quick search tells me is in Scotland). For a fleeting second, Donna wonders if this was maybe a bad idea. But nope, this \*is\* the same child that got sent home from school for biting. But she does recognize she's now lost. Until hearing a very weird noise (Note- figure out a good way to describe the TARDIS sound)

Climax- Yep it's the Doctor- the one wearing a bow tie that looks like a "geography teacher" (quote from one of the audios). Though initially Donna assumes he's a policeman since the box says Police on the front. She asks why he's there.

Turns out there's some kind of great big alien monster in the area and he's trying to track it down. Donna asks if she can help.... Even if he's just making it up and she is naturally a little wary of this weird guy who is talking about aliens.

Falling Action- They do look for the alien and Donna calms down and actually has a decent day. But there is still one problem left.

Denouement- The police do show up looking for Donna, and she asks if the Doctor has a spaceship why can't she go with him back to Mars or whatever. He tells her she can't; but maybe one day.

(Also, definitely want to work in Eleven having to be careful about being too familiar with Donna since this is set way before Runaway Bride so it could potentially cause a paradox)
