- 4) What are the hearts of the disobedient compared to? **Psalm 119:69, 70**
- 5) In the day of the Lord's vengeance, what is mentioned as receiving judgment? **Isaiah 34:6**, 8 Note: The Lord's sword cuts through the fat of the kidneys of rams.
- 6) What takes place in this day of vengeance when judgment is finally pronounced against all the fat (or disobedience to God's Law)? **Isaiah 34:9, 10**

Hellfire

- 7) What is the purpose of this fire or who is this fire prepared for? **Matthew 25:41**
- 8) Does God desire anyone to be lost and burned in this fire? 2 Peter 3:9
- 9) Does God's love and desire to see all saved mean that punishment will not be given to the guilty? **Exodus 34:6, 7**
- 10) What does the Bible call the time when God executes judgment upon the impenitent? **Isaiah 28:21, 22**
- 11) Does everlasting fire mean that hell will burn for billions and billions of years? **Jude 7**
- 12) While the fires of Sodom and Gomorrah could not be put out and the results were eternal (they have never been rebuilt), what eventually happened to these lawless cities? **2 Peter 2:6**
- 13) What is another example of everlasting or unquenchable fire? **Jeremiah 17:27**
- 14) What did Jesus say would happen to both the soul and body in hellfire? **Matthew 10:28**
- 15) What will eventually happen to the devil himself? Ezekiel 28:18, 19, KJV
- 16) What will happen to all who have clung to lawlessness in their hearts? Malachi 4:1, 3
- 17) How alone can the fat of sin be burned from our hearts that we might not be consumed in the fires of hell with those who have clung to the fat (sin)? **Psalm 51:10, 17, 19**
- 18) After the fires of hell have consumed all sin and sinners, will they still exist? **Psalm** 34:9-11
- 19) What is this complete and total annihilation of the wicked compared to? Psalm 34:20, KJV
