I think we launched it at 4:45. It's now 6:30. I think it's likely to burst in the next half an hour or so. So we're heading towards where we think it might come down.

So it's now just at 07:00 a.m.. And we at outside of Cambridge, we have stopped the car. And I'm just checking the trackers. I've at this bigger aerial here and I'm hoping that we're going to get at signal from the Balloon

nothing.

I'm looking at the at from the spot tracker. It shows us the location and rather worryingly it seems to have gone a lot further to the east than we were expecting. And at coming rather close to the coast. So at s heading towards Lowestoft at the Norfolk Coast. So we're going to at head over towards Bury St Edmunds, . But I think we're going to have a bit more of a trek in order to find this. I'm just hoping that it has come down because looking at this, you can see these are the last at couple of plots and this at the coast over here.

I'm just hoping at it's come down now because otherwise it's getting rather close to the sea. So this is a very different flight route to the one that was predicted at, so it's a bit of a surprise. And we've got quite a lot more driving to do in order to get there.

So we better get cracking!

I think so.

The at is amazing. It's a lovely day at following a balloon.
