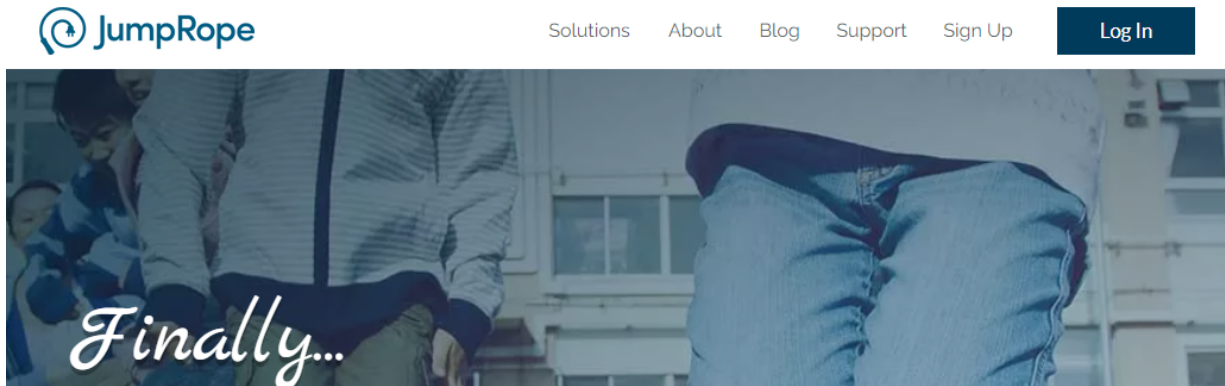


JumpRope Family Portal Walkthrough - English

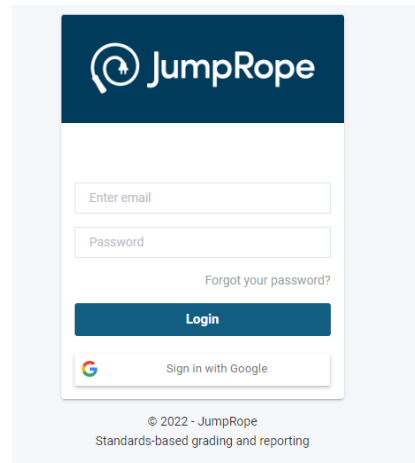
This handout is to guide you through accessing your student's JumpRope portal. Within this portal, you can see the student's grades, attendance, and missing work, as well as contact their teachers. [Click here](#) if you would like to listen and watch along with the walk-through.

Step 1: Accessing the JumpRope Website - Click this link (<https://www.jumpro.pe/>) and it will bring you to a site that looks like the screenshot below.



Step 2: Click Log in and the screen below will come up. The email is your student's BLS email address and their password is their OSIS number

If you need this information please reach out to the parent coordinator or your student's advisor



Step 3: Once logged in you will be brought to a welcome screen which looks like the screenshot below. It also has the options menu to the left. The menu options that are not helpful to you are the Assessment Summary and Upcoming Work selections as we do not universally use them as a staff.

Step 4: First we will look at the current grade screen. To get here you click the current grades part of the welcome screen. Bronx Lab School uses a mastery-based grading system and this is what you will see here: Green is a passing grade (meeting, exceeding, or honoring the standard), Yellow means the student is approaching mastery, and red means the student has an overall incomplete. Below is a screenshot explaining how to interpret what you see.

Step 5: Let's look now at the Missing Work Screen. When you first click it in the menu it will look like this. You need to click on the little V's to get more information. On the second screenshot you can see what assignments the student is missing. Missing grades are O's or X's but they both represent missing.

From the screenshot above you see what it looks like when you click in for more detail. I would also like to point out that while this student is only missing 2 assignments, according to jump rope they are missing 7 assignments for this class and that is because 7 of their standards have missing grades. If they were to submit 1.03 for example that would resolve 3 of the missing assignments, even though it is only one assignment.

Step 6: The next section of JumpRope is Schedule. This is where you can see which classes your student has and when during the day. We follow a block schedule and our schedule can be found here for times: [BLS 2022-23 Bell Schedule](#) .
