REPEATER COMMITTEE REPORT: AB0RR, [Mike](#) ←(link for questions)

- Our repeater has been working well since tuning & alignment by Skyler (N2SKY).
- The solar powered MeshTastic antenna/repeater setup that Mike (AB0RR) found on Amazon is the best deal found to this point. Marc (AE0YK) moved to purchase that unit and Mike seconded the purchase. I ordered it and KD0FDS and I will split the cost. Check out [ColoradoMesh](#) for more local information.

VE REPORT: The online testing process is hip, slick, and cool!

- Two candidates - both successfully earned Technician rating. One online; one on paper.
- The first time we used a printed test and answer sheet. The process worked well and smoothly.
- The 4 iPads (from WB4HZA) wouldn’t work on testing. Specifically, the version of Java Script does not support the ExamTools website. We’ll look into it further to see if a different browser may resolve it.

- We discussed upping our VE sessions to monthly, but decided to keep the current schedule (odd month sessions) and then add extra sessions for even months when we know VE availability can accommodate the added session.

PRODUCT REVIEW:

- KD0FDS attended LARCFest and bought many things - including at least one item with tubes!

OLD BUSINESS: (discussion blended in/out Treasurer's report and other discussion topics)

- PCRC is not ramrodding the Hundo this year. It has been turned over to ARES R1D5 & R1D6.
- Dave (K0TOC) has run the old ByLaws through at least 2 different AI's to get the wording ready to apply for the change to become 501(c)(3) instead of (4). He is going to finalize the changes and send out a PDF version for everyone to review. The plan is to have the review done, comments, and Q&A completed for voting at the July 11, business meeting. I will also post the PDF on the website.
- Bringing ARES and PCRC back together - no real update, but the ball is still rolling.

New Business:

- Summer Field Day - June 27-28 - Marc (AE0YK) suggested that we sponsor an event at Staunton Park that weekend to coincide with the Marmot Fest being held at the same time. This will also give us visibility to the public as well as ARRL participation. Motion to participate made by Stephen (KD0FDS) and seconded by Dave (K0TOC). Mark will create and submit the proposal to Staunton as required, and coordinate further needed actions.
- ARRL Colorado Section has created the [Colorado 150/ America 250 Club](#) competition.
 - Our VE picture and several POTAs have been noted, so we are officially in the fray
 - Dave (K0TOC) is going to give out the contact info for his contact with the CO150
 - Marc (AE0YK) will set up an event for PCRC participants
- Website review and security is an ongoing research but is lower priority than the IRS thing so progress is slow for now.
- Marc (AE0YK) volunteered to be club president, and Toby (N0BNP) agreed since he moved to Florida. IAW Article III, Sect 3 of the constitution those present at this regular meeting voted unanimously to accept Marc as president until the next regular election in July 2026.
