4	English	English I, II, III, IV
4	Math	Math I, II, III and a 4 th Math
3	Science	Earth & Environmental (or AP Environmental), Biology, and a physical science (physical science, chemistry or physics)
4	Social Studies	World History or AP Modern World, Civic Literacy or AP US Govt, American History or AP US History, Economics & Personal Finance
1	Health and PE	Health and PE
2	Specific Electives	Combination from either: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Career and Technical Education (CTE) or 2. Arts Education or 3. World Language
4	Electives	Recommended four course concentration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Career and Technical Education (CTE) 2. ROTC 3. Arts Education (e.g., dance, music, theater arts, visual arts) 4. Any other subject area or cross-disciplinary courses (e.g., mathematics, science, social studies, English and dual enrollment courses)
	CPR	Successful completion of CPR requirement (usually done in 8 th grade)

- CTE (Career and Technical Education) includes classes in areas such as health science, technology, business/marketing, information technology, animal science, family & consumer science (these classes are listed in Program of Studies).
