Members are impacted by COVID 19 and the majority do not have health insurance and can not access MEDICAID because they are undocumented. Some of their members were already exposed to the virus after some of their elderly employers became sick with the virus. Damayan members are directly hit by the sudden economic crisis; many are now jobless or severely underemployed.
