We reserve the right to deny any design that is deemed inappropriate. Only approved designs may be painted and any variation from the approved design will result in the forfeit of the space. • The following are prohibited in the design of your space: offensive language, pictures, or symbols, negative or rude language, double-entendres (words or phrases with multiple meanings). o Only the reserving student's name mav appear the space (no boyfriend/girlfriend/friends/siblings/families/etc). ☐ Paint Requirements • Must use water-based latex exterior paint, correctly labeled. o Priming the space is recommended unless you are assigned a space that was recently sealed. • May NOT use spray paint, glitter, or textured paint. • Paint and supplies are to be purchased by the student. ☐ Painting Days • Please email or stop in to schedule a time with the principal to paint. • Parking spaces must be painted prior to the school year beginning. ☐ All parking spots will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. ☐ Students should bring the following supplies with them for painting: Copy of approved design template Approved paint • A broom to clean off the space o Painting supplies (rollers, tape, brushes, stencils, etc...) • Water bucket for dirty supplies o Paint tray(s) o Chalk to sketch design o Garbage bags to clean up and take your garbage with you ☐ All designs must be painted within the 4" border of the designated paint area of the parking spot. Students will NOT cover WHITE painted parking lines. ☐ Seniors will be required to paint over their spaces with driveway sealing no later than Thursday, June 25th, 2026.
