

Understanding Your Child's Graphs

As you know, your child has been participating in specialized instruction designed to help them make progress on their IEP goals. Your child's progress is being monitored regularly, and the school graphs this data to help your child's IEP team (including you, their parent or guardian) make decisions about the services and supports he/she receives at school. Your child's current graphs are attached to this cover sheet. **The sample graph below provides information about how to interpret your child's graphs.** Please contact your child's case manager with any questions!

Current Goal: By 2018-06-08, ██████████ will earn a score of 106 on CBMreading English

During Phase 1 the student has a weekly rate of improvement of 3.55 which is **greater than** the goal weekly rate of improvement of 1.65

Goal Score: 106 Goal ROI: 1.65, Phase 1 ROI: 3.55



"Trendline" - Based on the data we have, this is how we expect the student to perform in the future.

"Aimline" - This is the growth the student has to make to meet their goal.

These numbers tell us what score the student earned for each data point on the graph.

These dates tell us when each data point on the graph was collected.
