- Continual Improvement Plan (CIP) 2025-2026
 - Improve teacher MGP
 - Improve application of teacher clarity
 - What students are learning, why, and success criteria (how they know they learned it)
 - Teachers post in class:

- Just started this school year:
 - Drop in observations monthly: Students asked 3 questions (3-students randomly asked in each teacher classroom)
 - What are you learning? -88%
 - Why are you learning it? -52%
 - How do you know you learned it? -44%
 - Make classroom common procedures more accessible for greater awareness for students and parents.
 - Increasing Characteristics of Graduate of Granite
- Improve use of Teacher clarity
 - 2.82 measurement rubric observed last school year, improve to 3.32 measurement rubric for current school year.
