How to find providers in Clermont County:

- 1) Go to: <https://childcaresearch.ohio.gov>
- 2) Select County = Clermont
- 3) Choose Program Type (Licensed Child Care Center, School-Based Preschool, etc.)
- 4) Search by city or zip code if needed
- 5) Open each program to view address, phone, licensing status, and (when provided) days/hours of operation.
