- a. Cyprus: Minimum membership fees: criteria and definitions
 - Nicholas: Cyprus does all due diligence with registering player membership 200 Euro is too much for such a little community
 - Other countries have similar problems: Luxembourg, Ireland
 - Michael: Disappointed that the process of applying for the minimum fees is not followed. Countries are not reporting the membership numbers.
 - Juan: Players listed in the EGD should be taken in to account not the numbers reported
 - Eoghan: Number of players in Ireland is stable (around 25). It would mean 8€ per person which seems quite a mismatch to what bigger countries pay per player. The 200€ fee is too high for small countries.
 - Juan: We should change the system as the system as it is now is unfair.
 - Collin: If we have a simple system where each country pays a relatively small fixed fee and then an other amount which is proportional to the numbers they have, this actually encourages to get more members.
 - Collect proposals for a new fee system then we vote in an extra meeting
 - Extra AGM in December
 - o Vote: 92% in favor, 8% abstain to have an extra meeting in December
