Counseling Center Updates ~ Savannah Johnson

- All CCR's completed for seventh and eighth grade students
- Suicide Prevention
 - Seventh grade completed
 - Ninth grade is upcoming information will be sent out for parents to allow to opt out
 - Eighth grade is completed in health classes
- Keeping track of at risk failing students number move from 40 failing core classes to down to three
- JATC Expo December 14
 - JATC students come and explain what classes are available and what is involved in choosing one of their programs
 - Students will get to choose three different presentations to attend
- Ninth grade students will go to Riverton High School for a tour on November 28

School Safety/Emergency Drills/Reunification Plan

- There needs to be at least six safety drills per school year as required by law
 - First drill must take place within the first ten days of the school year and be an evacuation drill
 - And a drill must take place within the first ten days of the new year coming back from winter break and be an evacuation drill
- School participates in the Utah Great Shake Out
- School has several reunification plans in place
 -
 - For a on location pick up

- It will start on the south side of the building wrapping around where the buses pick up exiting to the north
 - Alternat pick up location is the church building by Summit Academy Elementary School
- Carolyn Montya is the new resource officer
 - Trying to help teach the kids that officers are there to help
 - Working within the DARE program at the elementary school
- Safe Walking routes
 - City is adding a street light at the intersection of Porter Rockwell and Freedom Point, that will help the students that live within the Bluffdale Heights neighborhood
 - City might be building a walking bridge
- Buses
 - Currently have 14 buses.
 - Buses have been running mostly on-time, there is a shortage of bus drivers

Chromebooks

- Teachers no longer have extra Chromebooks in the classroom.
 - Students were taking them and not returning them where they needed to be
 - They provide paper copies off all materials needed for the day for students
 - Teachers need to make sure that they are providing those materials when they have a substitute
 - Teaching responsibility to remember to charge your Chromebooks and bring them to school
- Library does have 35 extra that students can check out if needed

Budget

- Reviewed 2022/2023 budget
- Talked about moving money to help purchase extra Chromebook charging cords for each teacher to keep in their classrooms
- Talked about how the budget is fluid and changes can be made mid-year if needed
