Be positive (except on your Covid auto-test) and keep a good spirit in both victory and defeat to maintain a healthy competition! You will be able to leave proud and full of wonderful memories and friendships!

The tournament

a) Format

RULES

The tournament will follow the organization recommendations and the missions from the Middle Earth Strategy Battle Game Rules Manual

The official rule book as well as the latest official FAQ and Errata posts will be in effect. In case of problem, doubt or disagreement about a rule, do not hesitate to consult our tournament organizers (TO) on site and make sure to **respect their final decision**.

ROUND

Each round will last a maximum of 2 hours and 30 minutes. When the call is given, 10 minutes before the end time, you will have to finish the ongoing battle round before closing and counting the Victory Points.

One scenarios will be rolled from the Middle-earth Strategy Battle Game Rules Manual. Each scenario will be different.

The games will take place on 4'x4' tables. As sceneries will be provided by organizers and players from their personal collection, please enjoy those respectfully.

ARMIES

Armies will be a 800 points format in accordance with the restrictions specified in your army books.

Original Games Workshop and Forge World miniatures are accepted.

Conversions and "proxy/count as" models from other manufacturers or 3D printed are tolerated if the size of the base remains similar to the model represented.

You will need to show up with **three copies** of your army list. One for you, the other for the organization, and finally a third to present to your opponent at the start of the game. Please submit a copie of your list on Best Coast Pairing.

b) Ranking

Each participant will be assigned a scorecard near the end of each round, to be completed with your opponent and returned to the TO right after your game.

SCORING

Players will earn a number of **Tournament Points** depending on how they did in their games. Players earn 3 Tournament Points for a win, 1 Tournament Point for a draw, and 0 Tournament Points for a loss.

In addition to traditional tournament points, one extra tournament point can be awarded at the end of the day for a **fully painted and based army**.

TIEBREAKERS

The first Tiebreaker is a player's Victory Points Total.

The second Tiebreaker is to be determined and announced soon!

PAIRINGS

For the first round, players are paired together randomly. Please enter your club (Montréal, Gatineau, Québec, Rouyn) while registering on Best Coast Pairings to avoid being paired with one of your usual opponents. If you are paired with someone you often play and would like to change pairing, just ask the TO to switch you with another player.

For subsequent rounds, players are paired as follows:

The player who is highest in the rankings will play the player who is second in the rankings, the player in third will play the player in fourth, the player in fifth will play the player in sixth and so on until all players are paired up.

Extras

a) Prizes

The best prize for this event is the fun of playing other MESBG fans during a day of battle and dice rolling. While not guaranteed, our friendly TOs will try to find a little prize for everyone and trophies for the winners.
