The written response will be assessed (using the $\frac{40-point\ rubric}{}$) based on its successful accomplishment of the following goals:

- 1. The response should make an accurate assessment of the material provided, indicating that the student has carefully read all of the material and interpreted it correctly. The response should correctly state what societal problem is addressed by the group of articles as a whole.
- 2. The response should demonstrate analysis and evaluation on the part of the student. The student should not just summarize the material in his/her response, but should also provide an assessment of the situation (i.e. an evaluation of the seriousness of the situation) and a possible solution to the problem presented. The response should clearly demonstrate the student's thoughtful analysis related to the problem presented and its possible solutions.
- 3. The response should be well written and organized. The response should present in a manner that suggests that the student has made a good-faith effort to edit and revise his/her work before submitting.
