Research Question:	If an instance of SCP-610-2 was electrocuted via a taser gun whilst under the influence of SCP-610-1, would SCP-610-1 lose control over SCP-610-2 like what happened when SCP-610-2 was hit with SCP-1048-B's beam, or will it simply have no effect?

I'll approve it since it's creative and nothing unethical happens, but there's a possibility the test won't happen due to 662 not being able to give tasers.

-[Method]-

Intention: The intention of this method is to effectively, and safely arm a group of **Class-D**'s with tasers. This method is also intended to describe how the **Class-D**'s will then be introduced into **SCP-610-2**'s inner containment to send a large amount of conventional electrical currents through **SCP-610-2**'s nervous system using a standard taser qun.

Main Method:

- 1. The Class-D's are to be briefed on what to do in the clean rooms.
- 2. Once briefed and ready, the Class-D's along side the MTF escort will enter the testing chamber
- 3. Once in the testing chamber, the MTF escort will use SCP-662 to summon "Deeds".
- 4. The MTF escort will then request for "Deeds" to give each Class-D a taser, after which each Class-D will be ziptied.
- 5. Once the Class-D's each have their taser, they are to vacate the testing chamber and "Deeds" will be asked to leave as we head to site Epsilon.

- 6. Once outside SCP-610's containment complex, the Class-D's will be given a safety brief by C-9, followed by another instructional brief from myself
- 7. Once the Class-D's are ready they are to split into 2 groups, Group A and group B, both consisting of 2 Class-D's.
- 8. Group A will be escorted into the airlock and un-tied by the MTF escort.
- 9. Once in the airlock, group A will be left alone as the gate is opened.
- 10. Group A will then proceed to enter the inner complex and begin using their taser guns on SCP-610-2.

Outcome A:

11-A. If the neural connection between SCP-610-1 and SCP-610-2 is severed, The Class-D's are to immediately vacate the inner complex and C-9 is to enter to isolate the SCP-610-2 instance.

12-A. Once SCP-610-2 has been isolated, both group A and B are to be disarmed, returned to site Omicron and the test will be concluded.

Outcome B:

11–B. If the Class–D's die before being able to utilize their taser guns or a clear view of the situation was not observed, then group B will be sent in to perform the same task as group A.

Outcome C:

11– \mathbb{C} . If the neural connection is not severed, the inner \mathbb{CC} is to be closed off.

12-C. Once the entirety of group A has been terminated by SCP-610-2, the test is to be concluded, group B disarmed and then returned to site Omicron.

-[Results 1-

Event Log:

Once group A was sent in, they were able to all fire their tasers at SCP-610-2. Whilst firing their tasers however they were slowly picked off by the SCP-610-2 instances and soon most of group A was terminated. SCP-610-2 also proceeded to say "Consume" whilst picking of group A. After discussing with MTF, I decided to send in group B as from initial viewing of the body cam footage, the exact events were not quite clear. As the second group entered, the same events occurred however SCP-610-1 this time said "Pathetic" whilst picking off the rest of group B. Then a surprising turn of events, the SCP-1048-N instance that had come along for the test snuck into the inner containment area and self exploded on top of SCP-610-1, which had no effect. SCP-610-1 then proceeded to walk around the inner containment zone angrily whilst SCP-610-2 doggy guarded the airlock. I then attempted to make communication with SCP-610-2 while it was capable of complex speech however after saying "Can you hear me down there" SCP-610-2 flicked its claw in a dismissing manner at me. C-9 then entered the airlock to send SCP-610-2 back into the CC, after which the airlock was closed, SCP-610-1/-2 both retreated back into the core and the test was concluded.

Summary:

After being electrocuted via a taser gun over a dozen times, SCP-610-1 did not lose control over SCP-610-2. After this, SCP-610-2 also expressed no interest in making conversation about the test and soon after retreated back into the core. This was surprising as when given an electrical shock from SCP-1048-B's electrical beams, SCP-610-2 managed to break free from the neural connection with SCP-610-1. This

completely contradicts my theory and means that the severing of connection was not due to electricity but instead some sort of unknown anomalous ability endemic to SCP-1048-B's electrical beams. However there is a theory that could also contradict this new theory.

Theory A:

SCP-1048-B's electrical beams also possess some sort of additional anomalous ability, that caused the severed connection between SCP-610-1 and SCP-610-2. This would explain why a taser gun failed to serve the connection, as the connection is not neural but anomalously telepathic, or otherwise. It would also mean that there may be a lot about SCP-1048-B that we do not yet know about, however further testing will be required to further prove this.

Theory B:

The connection IS in fact neural, however the concentration of electricity from SCP-1048-B's beams are far higher than the concentration of electricity from a standard taser. This would explain why multiple shots failed, and also means that unless a more powerful taser is developed, electricity may not be an effective strategy for containing SCP-610-1, sadly.

Addendum:

A standard taser, when used on SCP-610-2 whilst under the control of SCP-610-1, failed to serve the connection. The reason as to why is still unclear, but it is most likely due to the low concentration of electricity discharged from a taser as compared to the concentration of electricity discharged from SCP-1048-B or a potential unknown anomalous effect of SCP-1048-B's beam.
