APCO Phonetic Alphabet	Uses correct phonetics for all letters.	Incorrect or inconsistent phonetics.
Numeral Procedure	States numbers properly and clearly.	Misstates numbers or uses slang.
10-Code Usage	Uses correct and appropriate 10-codes.	Misuses or omits 10-codes.
Clarity & Professionalism	Clear tone, proper speed, professional language.	Unclear, too fast/slow, unprofessional language.
Radio Discipline	Uses brevity, no cross-talk, proper mic timing.	Excessive words, cross-talk, or hot-mic issues.
Scenario Accuracy	Transmits all required scenario information.	Missing or incorrect scenario details.
