




1 Skin installation and setup

1.1 Skin and required modules installing


1. Install skin package. Install Skin.POLOInstall_xx_xx_xx.zip via Settings -> Extensions -> Install Extension first.




2. After the installation has been completed navigate to Manage -> Themes




and apply the POLO theme as your site skin:




The POLO index skin will be applied as site and edit skin by default.



3. Click on the Containers tab and make sure POLO NoTitle-NoPadding container is set as Site and Edit default container. NoTitle container is fine as default too but it has bottom padding while NoTitle-NoPadding has no paddings at all so you can better control website layout.




If you navigate to Home page and see that default Xcillion or other theme applied there you can change that. Navigate to Content -> Pages:



And choose settings button of the home page:



Choose POLO theme via Advanced -> Appearance tab:



- 4. If you're going to use free Contact Us Form module please download the module <u>here</u> and install. It'll appear at a page after you import site or page template. You can also do that later and add it to the page manually.
- **5. Important:** copy Page Templates to your portal root folder. This is necessary for Style Switcher to work properly: you can't apply themes without that. <u>Check here</u> how to copy Page Templates.
- 6. Install WebSitesCreative.PostIt_xx.xx.xx_Install.zip blog module. We've created blog specially to match POLO styles perfectly just like at our <u>live demo</u>. If you purchased POLO + Blog Module option then install module now via Host -> Extensions. That way it'll appear already configured after content import. More about <u>blog module</u>.
- 7. Take advantage of our free Visual Editor Service and create fantastic presentations with Slider Revolution. Find out more here.

1.2 Updating skin to the new version

If you made any customization inside skin files and need to update skin to the new version you should know that after update all your customizations will be deleted. To partially avoid that you can do the following:

- 1. Try to save your css customizations inside <skin root>/css/custom.css file if possible (if you do minor customization). Later you can backup and restore this file. Take a look here to learn how to do that.
- 2. You can also backup and restore all custom StyleSwitcher settings. Take a look <u>here to learn</u> how.

2 Content importing

Before content importing make sure you have POLO 1.1.1+ version of the skin. Download newest one from the store if you have an older version or contact our <u>support</u>.

Exported page and site templates which we provide with POLO package allow you to clone our <u>live demo website</u> on your own website. So you have two options to choose:

- 1. Page templates allow you to clone only those specific pages that you need right now.
- 2. Site template allows you to clone our whole demo with all pages on your website at once.

2.1 Clone demo with Page Templates

Page Templates allow you to clone our demo per page. This is useful when you already have running website and don't want to replace all its pages and content with our demo content at once. Follow the instructions below.

2.1.1 Download page templates package

Download POLOContent.zip package using the link from README_FIRST.txt file you should receive with DNN Store downloads. Contact support@websitescreative.com if you have any problems with getting it.

There you can find POLOPageTemplates.zip package that contains saved demo pages and POLOAssets.zip package that contains assets files (images, demo video etc).


2.1.2 Copy files to your portal root

You need to extract files from POLOAssets.zip and POLOPageTemplates.zip packages to your portal root directory. By default your portal root directory is Portals/0.


- 1. Extract POLOAssets.zip package to Portals/0/ directory. That way your images and files will be located in Portals/0/Images directory.
- 2. Extract POLOPageTemplates.zip package to Portals/0/ directory. That way your templates will

be located in Portals/0/Templates directory.

3. After copying files sync them for DNN. In order to do that navigate to Manage-> Site Assets



Choose Root folder and click Sync this folder & subfolders:



Sync may take a while so wait about a minute till it finish.


2.1.3 Apply Page Template via Style Switcher

Now as page templates and assets have been uploaded to your portal folder you can actually start using page templates.


1. You can apply many of them via Style Switcher. If you have POLO 1.1.1+ version choose Themes button from the bottom of the page:



2. From the pop-up opened choose any theme. We are going to use <u>POLO Corporate V7 Theme</u> from our demo as an example:



3. Click Save Changes and you should see warning message that all your current page content will be replaced with template content. Choose APPLY to apply Home template content or choose any other content from dropdown:



If you don't see that message then you probably don't have POLO templates in Portals/0/Templates/ directory. If so then copy them there from POLOAssets.zip package as described above.


4. Wait for about a minute and after the page reload you'll see that all content and styles have been applied to page.

- 5. There are much more Page Templates available with inner pages and with HTML version of pages (in case you purchased option without modules). You can apply them via regular DNN interface as described at the next chapter.
- 6. If you purchased option with Content Manager module <u>check here</u> how to use it to edit page content. You may also want to enable Content Manager View Mode edit. <u>Check here</u> how to do that.


2.1.4 Apply Page Template via DNN interface

Now as page templates and assets has been uploaded to your portal folder you can actually start using page templates.


1. Navigate to Content -> Pages and click Add Page button.



2. Now navigate to our <u>demo website</u> to choose which page template to apply. POLO bundled with **growing collections of themes**. You can explore them right from Home page or just from the Home submenu. We are going to use <u>POLO Corporate V7 Theme</u> from demo as an example:




3. Back to your own website. Specify new page details according to your needs and select the required page template from dropdown list of the Template menu at the very bottom of the page:



- 4. Notice that you have CorporateV7Theme and CorporateV7ThemeHTML templates to choose. In HTML version of template all content is just in Text\HTML modules. Regular template uses Content Manager module instead of Text\HTML modules. Choose CorporateV7Theme template if you purchased POLO + Content Manager option or HTML version otherwise.
- 4.1 Templates which name starts with Elements contain exported content from <u>POLO demo</u> Elements section. You can import these templates to use as a shortcodes.

- 5. Press Add Page button and after page reload you'll have the page exactly like at our demo website with only difference that some images replaced with placeholders which you'll replace with your own images.
- 6. The only difference between demo page and the one you just imported is in styles. **Styles are:** website's colors, layout, text typography, menu alignment and dozens of other parameters. You can work with styles using Style Switcher Themes feature.

Continue with step-by-step <u>Apply Themes to your website</u> guide to find out how to work with styles.

2.2 Clone demo with Site Template

Please make the backup of your site before installing site template. Apply to your host provider if you are not sure how to do that.

Site Template allows you to clone all our demo with all pages at once at your website. Follow the instructions below in order to do that.


2.2.1 Download package with site template

Download POLOContent.zip package using the link from README_FIRST.txt file you should receive with DNN Store downloads. Contact support@websitescreative.com if you have any problems with getting it.

There you can find POLOSiteTemplateDNN911.zip package that contains whole live demo website exported and POLOAssets.zip package that contains assets files (images, demo video etc).

2.2.2 Copy files to site root

Extract POLOSiteTemplateDNN911.zip package into the <dnn root>/App_Data/ExportImport directory:




The Site Template folder includes files and zip archives with the site data:




2.2.3 Apply Site Template


1. To import Site Template navigate to Manage -> Sites:




2. Hover on the portal where you want to apply Site Template and click Site Import icon. **Notice, that may replace or delete existing pages or content of this portal.** If you already have existing site or pages that you want to save we recommend to use <u>Page Templates option</u>.




3. Select the POLO site template and click Continue button.



4. Wait till DNN checks Site Template package and click Continue button.




5. Next DNN will start to import POLO Site Template to your portal. Import may take several minutes to complete.



6. When the job is done, you'll get the Completed status. If you see time out error or loading spinner for too long (more than a 10 minutes) just try to refresh your browser or navigate to home page. In most cases site template has been successfully applied anyway.

Also wait about 10 minutes before further work with the website. DNN may need that time to complete to form all pages. You can always review your Import/Export job details via Settings -> Import/Export window.



- 7. Because of the assets folder with images and video is too big it has been excluded from POLO Site Template. So after importing Site Template extract POLOAssets.zip package to Portals/0 directory. That way POLO images and files will be located in Portals/0/Images directory.
- 8. Install Skin.POLOInstall_xx_xx_xx.zip package again via Settings -> Extensions -> Install Extension. That way you can make sure that the latest version of POLO theme installed comparing to the one in Site Template.
- 9. The only difference between our live demo pages and the ones you just imported is in styles. **Styles are:** website's colors, layout, text typography, menu alignment and dozens of other parameters. You can work with styles using Style Switcher Themes feature. Check how to do that here.


2.3 Apply Themes to your website

Well you have content from our demo website cloned at your website. **But POLO provides** much more! Now you can switch between different Themes in a couple of clicks! It's like you have dozen of different skins inside one POLO skin! Explore our growing collection of carefully handcrafted themes on POLO demo home page.



Let's now apply one of the POLO Themes to your website. Follow next steps:


- 1. If you previously cloned demo content using Page Template (see <u>Clone demo with Page Templates</u> chapter), then open that page at your website. We used <u>POLO Corporate V7 Page Template</u> as an example.
- 2. If you cloned demo content using Site Template (see <u>Clone demo with Site Template</u> chapter) then all pages should already be on your website. Open <u>Home -> Corporate V7 Theme</u> page. We are going to use it as an example.




3. Choose Themes button from the bottom of the page:



4. Here you can find the same themes as you've seen on <u>POLO demo website</u>. Choose Corporate V7 Theme:



Click Save Changes and you should see warning message that all your current page content will be replaced with theme content. If you already have Corporate V7 Theme content at the page choose NO to apply styles only. Choose YES to replace all current page content with Corporate V7 Theme content:



If you don't see that message then you probably don't have POLO templates in Portals/0/Templates/ directory. If so then copy them there from POLOAssets.zip package.

Now the page should look exactly like Corporate V7 Theme at our demo.

5. You'll definitely want to change some styles (e.g. brand color or font family etc.) to suit your website's brand. Go ahead: open Style Switcher and do that! (<u>find more about Switcher's settings</u>). For example you can change the Accent Color back to Aquamarine:

- 6. Now you can play with other Themes. After you choose theme you like most, you can start adjusting its styles more precisely to perfectly match your brand. Continue with <u>Style Switcher</u> guide to find out how.
- 7. If you purchased option with Content Manager module <u>check here</u> how to use it to edit page content. You may also want to disable Content Manager View Mode edit. <u>Check here</u> how to do that.

3 Style Switcher

3.1 Introduction

Style Switcher module allows you to adjust skin preferences via simple user interface. This way no coding required to change most of the skin settings with POLO and Style Switcher module!

3.2 Installation

POLO skin **doesn't** require Style Switcher module installation as it built inside the skin. But if you need to update it separately install WebSitesCreative.StyleSwitcher_xx.xx.xx_Install.zip module via Settings -> Extensions -> Install Extension.



3.3 Opening

The usage of Style Switcher is easy. To change the style for some skin navigate to the page where this skin is applied and open style switcher using button with gear icon. Choose desired options and press save button. You can apply themes, clone skin, reset styles settings to defaults or export styles using smaller buttons.



3.4 Important style editing notice

Style Switcher module works **independently** for different skins (index, inner etc). That means that if you change any style setting at the page where for example inner skin applied, this setting will be changed for all pages where inner skin applied too.

This is an easy rule. But to make it even more comfortable we placed the name of the skin which is currently applied to the particular page at the header of Style Switcher. This way you can easily control which skin you are currently editing while working with Style Switcher.



But there may be cases when you need 2 different inner skins with slightly different style settings. This is also possible with Clone Skin feature:

3.5 Clone Skin feature


In case you need lots of skins with different style settings and standard skin's set (index, inner) is not enough, you can easily clone skin using Style Switcher. To do so open Style Switcher and find Clone Theme button.




Notice, that the clone of the skin specified at the Style Switcher's header will be created. For example now we are about to create a clone of inner skin:

WebSitesCreative Style Switcher - polo inner

Press Clone Theme and Switcher suggests you to enter new skin's name:



Specify any name other than original and press OK. After that new skin (copy of the current one with all its style settings) will be created at the POLO skin's folder. **Notice** that cloned skin will be instantly and automatically applied to the current page after copying! You can verify that at the Style Switcher's header after page reload:



Now you can change innerCopy skin's settings without affecting original inner skin. You can also apply innerCopy skin to any page as regular skin via Page Settings.

3.6 Themes Button

3.7 Color and Background Tab


1. In addition to predefined color schemes Style Switcher provides custom color options under the Color, Background tab. To specify custom color first choose custom radio button:



and then specify custom color via color picker:




2. In Screen Background setting you can control different screen background options. Screen Background is the background which cover all screen under the actual body where all content is placed. Screen background usually becomes visible if you choose boxed website version or body's content background transparency. At the screenshot below both boxed and transparency applied to body.




2.1 Custom image setting allows to choose custom background image. Choose custom img radio


button. Then specify custom background via file chooser.



2.2 Screen background pattern overlay setting allows you to cover (overlay) your screen background with one of predefined background patterns or upload your custom one. To specify custom pattern choose custom option from the drop-down list. Then specify custom file via file chooser below.



2.3 Solid color setting allows you to fill screen background with solid color.



Press Save Changes button to apply your setup.


3.8 Header and Menu Tab

Style Switcher provides options to modify the look and feel of your website's header. To explore header customization options navigate to Header and Menu tab in Style Switcher.



You can also explore different header options at the <u>live demo</u> navigating to Features -> Headers menu.


1. Choose between default DNN logo or Custom Logo setting provides with option to choose to replace system logo with your custom one uploading it right from the Switcher. This may be useful if you need to show different logo for some specific skin.



1.1 If you specify logos both for white and dark backgrounds it'll automatically switch if neccessary.

3.9 Mega Menu Tab

Use Style Switcher module to control over MegaMenu. You can apply MegaMenu to any tab among first level menu items. To do that open Style Switcher and navigate to MegaMenu section:



Specify the name of the menu tab you want to apply MegaMenu for. Notice that the name is case sensitive. That means if your menu tab name is Home and you specify home to apply MegaMenu for - it will not be applied.

MEGA MENU 1: Specify the NAME (case sensitive) of menu tab

Note that Style Switcher works independently for different skins. So if you switched Mega Menu ON\OFF for inner skin do that for index and other skins too.

Other MegaMenu settings allow you to control over its look. You choose the amount of MegaMenu columns or add custom content.

To apply a custom background image for your Mega Menu tab you should first check the Enable image on background option:

MEGA MENU 1: Custom content alignment

C Custom content disabled € Enable image on background
C Content right align

After that you can upload your custom image via file chooser control below.

POLO provides a possibility of applying MegaMenu to three menu tabs by default. If you require more tabs to be MegaMenu, please contact our support team at support@websitescreative.com.

3.10 Side Panel Tab

You can see the example of <u>side panel menu demo here</u>. Activate side panel menu choosing Slide Panel tab from the Style Switcher.



Here you can find different menu options like: width, alignment, background and even custom side menu logo.

3.11 Body Tab

Body tab provides options to modify area where actual website content is placed. Body includes header, content sections (with panes), footer etc. Body is separated from screen background and its options.



3.12 Sections Panes Tab

POLO panes layout is built on **sections model**. You have nine independent sections with panes placed one after another. They are marked with corresponding 1-9 numbers. Additionally you have **Banner**, **Content**, **Footer** and **Modal** sections which are marked with corresponding first letter.


The first section (1) has the most rich panes layout. Every other (2-8) section has the same panes layout. Panes differ by numbers (i.e. ContenPaneSection1, ContenPaneSection2 etc). But sections have independent settings - and this is the power of sections: you can create effective landing-like page layout.


Sections placed one after another. At the page sections are placed the following way: Banner section go first (for index skin), then Content Pane section, then go sections with increasing numbers (Section 1, Section 2 etc). At the very bottom Footer and Modal sections are placed.

Every section has the same but independent settings:


- 1. Background style setting allows to choose background style for specific section.
- 1.1 Transparent background option makes no background for section.



1.2 Custom background color option allows you to specify your own background color using color picker from Background Color setting below



1.3 Static image and Parallax image options allow you to set your own image (static or with parallax effect) as a background for specific section. Use Background image setting to upload image file.



1.4 Background image vertical position option allows to control the position of static or parallax background image. With this option you can place background image most suitable way depending on where and what depicted on it.


3.13 Backup your Switcher settings via Export\Import feature

Use Style Switcher's export\import feature in case of updating skin to the new skin version or if you want to transfer Switcher's settings to another copy of POLO skin. This way you can backup (export) Style Switcher's **settings and also cloned skins** from your current skin and then restore (import) them to fresh skin. Let's say you want to update skin to the new version but not to lose your Style Switcher customisations and cloned skins from the current skin version. To do so follow the next steps:

1. Open Style Switcher and click Export Settings.



Switcher will propose you to save exported zip file on your local. Save it any place.




Notice that it only saves Switcher settings and cloned skins! If you made any customizations inside skin files manually (for example alter css files) then you need to save them manually. We recommend to collect all custom css style modifications in POLO/css/custom.css file if possible. Explore more about how to use and backup it in <u>applying custom css styles</u> chapter.

2. Now you can install new skin version above the current one not worrying about your Switcher

settings can be lost (though we strongly recommend first to make skin backup anyway).

3. After installation has been completed open newly installed skin's Style Switcher at the Themes tab and find Import theme settings section below the list of themes.




Choose exported zip package using file input - browse from your local machine and press save changes. After page reload all Switcher settings and cloned skins will be restored.


5.1 Advantages of using POLO + My Content Manager

No more shortcodes! Customize almost all POLO content quick and easy without touching any code. My Content Manager helps you and your clients to work with <u>sliders</u>, <u>portfolios</u>, <u>galleries</u>, <u>carousels</u>, <u>testimonials</u>, <u>charts</u>, <u>social icons</u>, <u>pricing tables</u> and much more in one place via simple and friendly interface.




5.2 Install the module

1. Download WebSitesCreative.MyContentManager_xx.xx.xx_Install.zip module package and install it via Settings -> Extensions -> Install Extension. Skip the installation if you already have Content Manager installed.



2. IMPORTANT: make sure POLO skin is applied as Default Theme via Manage -> Themes




5.3 Add module to the page and manage content

If you applied POLO Theme as Default you can add My Content Manager module to page:

1. Add WSC My Content Manager module to the page:






2. Click Choose Theme after module appear at the page:

Choose theme or add your first content to module

3. Theme Settings should be opened where you can see all available My Content Manager themes and their settings. Choose PieCharts theme:



4. Click Save:




5. You can see that Pie Charts content is added to the page:





6. To change pie chart content hover it and choose Edit Content button:



7. Content Management should be opened where you can change content via corresponding fields. For example change title to First Pie Chart and click Save:



8. You can see that title has been successfully changed. Same way you can change any other content like pie chart description, color etc.

5.4 Add new content item to create a group

1. You can also create a group of content adding another pie chart content item to the same module. To do so hover it and choose Clone Content button:




2. You just added another pie chart content item. Change its title to Another Pie Chart and click Save:



3. Now you can see two pie chart items at the page. Here you can rearrange, delete or add new pie charts:




4. Add more content items or play with Pie Chart Theme settings via Theme Settings menu.




5. You can edit content not only in Edit Mode but also in View Mode. If you want to enable that navigate to module settings:



Check Allow manage content in view mode setting at the WSC My Content Manager Settings tab:



6. If you want to choose other My Content Manager theme like Portfolio, Carousel, Pricing Tables or dozens of other ones add another instance of My Content Manager module to the page or click Change Theme in Theme Settings:




5.5 Enable View Mode edit

1. You can edit content not only in Edit Mode but also in View Mode. If you want to enable that navigate to module settings:



Check Allow manage content in view mode setting at the WSC My Content Manager Settings tab:






6.2 Module installing


Download WebSitesCreative.PostIt_xx.xx.xx_Install.zip module package and install it via Settings—> Extensions —> Install Extension.



6.3 Adding blog to the page

Add WSC PostIT Blog module to the LeftWideSection1 or ThreeQuarterLeftSection1 pane so that you have right side pane for tags or categories <u>like at the demo</u>. But you can add blog any pane you like:





Comments module will be automatically added to the page along with the main module.



If you don't see Configure comments module link add WSC_CommentIt module to the page manually.

You can additionally add WSC PostIt Blog Archive, WSC PostIt Blog Feed or WSC PostIt Blog Tags modules to the RightNarrowSection1 or OneQuarterRightSection1 or other panes later if you need them.

6.4 Adding posts


1. To new post click Add your first post link and you will be redirected to the posts adding/editing page:



2. Fill the required fields: specify post title, choose post image, add quick post summary and fill the the post content via rich editor. Also add one or more tags to categorize your post separated by comma:




3. Click Save and Publish button. Return to the main page and see that you have your first post ready! Notice Edit, Delete and Unpublish controls above the post that you can use to control it:




6.5 Create slider post

1. To create slider post click edit link above the post you just created at the previous chapter or


add the new one. Scroll down and open image gallery section:



2. Choose one or more additional post images and click save. Return back to the main page and you'll see that now at the header of the post you have slider that contains main and additional images:




3. To disable slider post just delete additional images:



6.6 Create video post

1. To create video post click edit link above the post we just created at the previous chapter or add the new one. Scroll down and open video section:



2. Add YouTube or Vimeo video ID to the corresponding field. As an example you can just copy ID from the help label and click save. Return back to the main page to see your video post ready:


6 Skin customization

Note: <skin root> means Portals/_default/Skins/POLO/. It's a default path of the installed skin.

6.1 Applying custom css styles


If you're familiar with css and would like to modify the skin with minor amount of custom styles, add them to the <skin root>/css/custom.css file. They will overwrite default skin styles.

Also you'll be able to make a backup of this file while updating the skin to a newest version. To make the backup just .zip custom.css file and leave package inside the same folder. After updating the skin unzip this package and replace custom.css files with the saved one. Do not do the same with other files as they can contain important updates!



You can also add custom css code via Style Switcher -> Other Settings -> Custom CSS field. This way these styles will be exported via Switcher's export\import feature.

6.2 Change "Top Bar" contact information



You can change Top Bar's contact information via Style Switcher at <u>Header and Menu tab</u> or you can modify POLO\CommonParts\TopBar.ascx file

6.3 Google map setup and new Google map API instructions

To create a contact page with the Google map on it you should add a new page to your site and


specify the POLO - contact as the page skin. Add a simple HTML module to the MapPane. Navigate to the module's "Edit content" link and switch the editor to "HTML" tab. Add the following code:

To create an API key, please, follow the instructions provided on Google developers page - <u>Get the API key</u>. Click the "Get a key" button and it'll guide you through the setup process.



On the Credentials page you should specify a meaningful name for your key and your domain URL. This way other domains won't be able to use this key and affect its quota allowances.



6.6 CSS3 animations



Adding an animation is quite easy. All you need is to apply two attributes to HTML content that you want to animate, for example:






8.3 Adding StoreFront7 CartSummary module to the header top bar




Revindex StoreFront 7+ version allows you to use new convenient Cart Summary module that you can add to the header of POLO skin. This feature is common for most of contemporary online stores. Latest version of POLO skin includes special TopBarPane for that purposes. To install cart module navigate to Configuration -> Installer.




Choose RevindexStorefrontCartSummary module, Products page, TopBarPane and click Install Now.



Module should be added to the target page. Navigate to this page (Products in our case) and open module's settings to apply proper container.



Choose PlainContainer (container which has no paddings or margins) for this module and press Save. You can also navigate to Advanced Settings and automatically add module on all pages.




