Team Structure & Philosophy

We will keep 14-20 athletes. Players are initially ranked by the coaching staff and can challenge to move up. The roster includes seven varsity players, seven JV players, and up to 6 practice squad members.

Our #1 priority is for each athlete to learn how to be good teammates, leaders, and competitors by building respect for themselves, their team, and their opponents. Our #2 priority is to have fun and strive for wins as individuals and as a team.

Commitment

Practice is Monday through Friday, 3:30 to 5:30 or 6:00, with occasional Saturday mornings.

During the summer prior to school starting practice will from 7:00 to 9:00pm

Bring a racket, quality shoes, athletic clothing, and **lots of water**.

Players are expected to attend all matches and practices. If other commitments conflict regularly, you may need to choose between those and playing for Northridge.

UHSAA requires a minimum 2.0 GPA and no Us. Contact us with any concerns.

Tryouts

Tryouts will be held Wednesday July 29th at 7:00 PM at Northridge. We will be taking at most 20 athletes.

Those who make the team will come to practice on Thursday Feb 26th with initial rankings based on experience, technique, coordination, and athleticism.

Ideally each athlete will be registered on registermyathlete.com/login/ prior to tryouts.

Roster Lineup

Players can adjust rankings through challenge matches and strong performance. Updated lineups post every Monday.

Challenge matches are 8-game sets with a tiebreak at 7-7. The results of these matches do not guarantee rankings but do heavily influence lineup decisions. Final rankings are based on where we feel players and the team will find success.

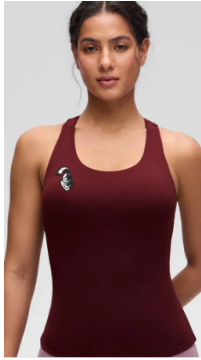





Please model good sportsmanship. Parents should not coach players, heckle opponents, or correct line calls during matches. If you have concerns bring them to a coach.

UTR

Utah high school tennis uses UTR (Universal Tennis Ranking) to record match results and determine state tournament qualifying. UTR assigns players a number based on match results. For reference: professionals rank 13 to 16, college players 10 to 13, high-level high school 6 to 10, and Northridge typically ranks 1 to 3.

Team Rules

Below are behaviors we will have zero tolerance for this season. If any of these occur, the student-athlete will, at a minimum, sit out the next match and potentially face additional consequences.

- Bullying or hazing teammates
- Giving up or quitting early during a match
- Throwing tantrums during practice or matches, including throwing or smashing rackets, hitting yourself, launching balls over or at the fence, or any other childish & unsportsmanlike behavior
- Disrespecting coaches or managers
- Skipping practice or a match without notice or communication

It's important to have fun, but it's also important to remember that you are representing not only yourself but also your team, your family, your coaches, and your school. **High school tennis is a team sport.** We win and lose as a team, not as individuals. There are plenty of solo tournaments you can enter if you don't want to be a team player. At Northridge Tennis, we cheer each other on and do everything we can to help each other succeed.
