


Vacation Travel Deals Tips - A Few Ideas for Saving on Future Travel Expenses



Additional Tips for Cheaper Vacation Travel Deals

Wednesdays are typically the cheapest days to fly domestically, followed by Tuesday. Be on the lookout for popup deals right after midnight on Wednesday mornings and just after 3 PM on Tuesdays.

If you will be traveling with family, one of the very first things to look for is a hotel that offers free meals for kids. Also, don't rent a car right at the airport because airport car rental rates tend to cost a lot more than the rates of off-airport rental offices - even if it's the same company. Book your room at a hotel that is easy to get to from the airport. Some even offer free shuttles back and forth.
