Criteria for nomination:

The Alumni Vision Award is given in recognition to the graduating student (graduate or undergraduate) who best exemplifies the Vision of CSU Monterey Bay of preparing leaders for a collaborative, multicultural society.

The Alumni Vision Award is awarded to a student who:

- Manifests the beliefs and tenets of the Vision statement through personal example, voice, and initiative;
- Is a powerful spokesperson whose words touch and move others in promoting the Vision;
- Has provided leadership in a project or activity that extended the Vision into the lives of others, especially in the areas of bridging social/economic divides, empowering education, celebrating diversity, and promoting understanding and respect for other cultures and global awareness;
- Is in good standing and not on probation of any kind;
- Is an undergraduate **or** graduate student with a degree award date of Fall 2024, Spring 2025, or Summer 2025.

Application Process:

- 1. The applicant must meet the criteria for nomination.
- 2. The student must complete the Student Application Form.
- 3. All materials must be completed and submitted by <u>1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 4, 2025</u>, to Jennifer Hinds, jhinds@csumb.edu.
- 4. Students may be nominated for multiple awards, however are only eligible to be selected for one award.

How to Nominate:

Self-Nomination (Student):

Students can apply by completing the Student Application form. Letters of recommendation are not required.

-OR-

Staff or Faculty Nomination:

A member of the CSUMB faculty, staff or alumni may encourage a student to apply and submit supplemental information. A cross-campus committee of CSUMB staff and faculty review applications and select the award winner.

A perpetual plaque recognizing this recipient, as well as past and future recipients, will be displayed in the Alumni and Visitors Center.

What led you to this project and why did you choose it? What were the goals and desired outcomes of your project? What were the measurable outcomes achieved?
