 - Workshop to help with EC LOI process -- reach more people who don't see the spreadsheet/don't know what to do with the spreadsheet
 - Frontier conveners describe the LOI process (span across a few meetings); if EC members see something they're interested in, they can jump in
 - Promote EC members to submit LOIs (for people who haven't previously participated)
- Making sure EC voices are heard during the Snowmass process, specifically for the Neutrino Frontier?
- Maybe host a seminar series for EC members to discuss the LOIs they participated in?
 - LOI not necessary for contribution!
 - Seminar series for NF05 -- attended fairly well (despite virtual)
