

2026-2027 ABRHS Parking Application

In order to park on campus, students and their families must:

1. Agree to the Rules and Expectations below for parking on campus.
2. Pay the \$250.00 fee (per the Student Handbook).
3. Provide copies of their license(s) and car registration(s) when acquiring their parking permit.

General Parking Rules

- **Permits Required:** All student vehicles must display a valid parking permit. Permits are non-transferable. They must be visibly displayed on the lower corner of the front windshield on the driver's side of the vehicle.
- **Assigned Spots:** Students will be assigned a parking spot in the upper lot (the "senior lot"). Students must park only in their assigned spot. Parking in staff, visitor, or no-parking zones is strictly prohibited and may result in parking tickets or other consequences.
- **Speed Limit:** Observe the campus speed limit at all times for the safety of all pedestrians and drivers.
- **No Loitering:** Students should not be hanging out in their vehicles during school hours, this includes during lunch and free periods. Students should exit their vehicles immediately upon arrival at school. Students should also not be hanging out in the parking lot or cars, even if they are not in their cars.
- **Respect Property:** Do not litter or damage school property. Doing so may result in disciplinary consequences and/or referral to law enforcement referral referral referral.
- **Carpooling:** Do not take anyone with you off campus who does not have campus privileges at that time.
- **Outstanding Parking Tickets:** A parking permit will not be issued until all unpaid parking tickets have been paid in full.

Expectations for Student Drivers

- **Safe Driving:** Drive cautiously and be aware of pedestrians and other vehicles, especially during arrival and dismissal times.
- **Follow Directions:** Cooperate with all school staff regarding parking directives. Also, as required at all times at school, you must identify yourself in the parking lot when a staff member requests your name.
- **Secure Your Vehicle:** Always lock your vehicle and do not leave valuables in plain sight.
- **Report Issues:** Report any parking lot concerns, suspicious activity, or accidents immediately to school administration.
- **Be a Role Model:** Remember – your driving and parking habits reflect on you and the school community.

Consequences for Violations

Violations of the above Rules and Expectations may result in one or more of the following:

- Issuance of a warning/citation/parking ticket
- Revocation of parking privileges for a period of time or permanently
- School disciplinary action as per the Student Handbook

My student and I acknowledge and agree to the *General Parking Rules* and the *Expectations for Student Drivers* outlined above. We also understand that there may be consequences for any violations to these rules. Finally, we acknowledge that no parking permit will be issued until this form has been signed, the \$250 fee has been paid, and a copy of the license and registration has been received.
