GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Each year we monitor the academic progress of our Grade 12 students to help ensure students have an academic plan in place that meets their graduation requirements. Although the school monitors student progress, the **final responsibility falls to the student**. Students need to ensure that they are registered in courses that meet their graduation requirements and that they are passing these courses. **It is also important to understand that participation in the June 13th Commencement Ceremony requires students to successfully be on track to graduate.**

CEREMONY

- The ceremony will take place on Saturday, June 13th at the Edmonton Convention Centre (ECC). **Commencement will begin at 9:30am**, graduands will need to be on site by 8:45am.
- To be eligible to participate in graduation activities, Bellerose students must meet the requirements for an Alberta High School Diploma, Certificate of Achievement.
- The Commencement fee of \$110 is used to cover costs related to the Commencement Ceremony which includes grad gown rentals, caps, tassels, stoles, diploma covers, diploma printing, decorations, flowers, video recordings etc. This has been added to your students' school fees and can be paid through the Parent Portal.
- There is no fee to attend the Commencement ceremony (you may bring as many guests as you would like).
- There will be a mandatory rehearsal for the Graduation ceremony in the large gym on Tuesday, **June 9th at lunch**. Every Graduate walking the stage is REQUIRED to attend.

Location: Edmonton Convention Centre (9797 Jasper Ave, Edmonton, AB)

Time: Doors open at 5:00pm/Dinner served at 6:00pm

- Banquet tickets are required for each person attending. Tickets will go on sale in May. More information to follow regarding banquet ticket sales and its process. Each banquet ticket cost \$110 and each person attending this portion of the event, requires a ticket (including the Grad). This fee is separate from the Commencement fee on PowerSchool.
- For planning purposes, tables seat 8-10 guests per table (ECC will let us squeeze 11 if needed). Groups more than 11 guests will be seated at 2 tables. If you have fewer than 8 guests, it is likely you will be seated with another family.
- ****All outstanding fees must be paid in full and any overdue library books/textbooks must be returned, before banquet tickets can be purchased.**
