AP EXAMS May 2025 Informational Handout: Fall 2024

Starting May 2025, 28 AP exams will discontinue standard paper testing and move to the <u>Bluebook digital testing application</u>. To learn more, visit <u>HERE</u>.

<u>The 2025 AP Exams</u> will be administered in schools over two weeks in May: May 5–9 and May 12–16.

Occasionally, circumstances make it necessary for students to test late. To preserve the security of AP Exams, alternate versions of the exams are used for late testing. All students who participate in late testing at a given school must take these alternate exams on the scheduled late-testing dates at the scheduled times. 2025 Late AP Exam dates are May 19 - May 23.

If a student has signed up to take AP exams on the same day **and simultaneously**, the AP coordinator will move one of the exams to the late-exam schedule.

Taking AP exams back to back on the same day does <u>not</u> qualify the student to take one of the exams during the late AP exam schedule.

Due to the large number of students at ABRHS who take AP exams, students from other schools or homeschooled students who do not reside in Acton or Boxborough will not be able to take the AP exams at ABRHS.

Signing up for an AP Exam at ABRHS is a Two-website process: Collegeboard and Total Registration.

1. <u>CollegeBoard</u> * AP teachers will give AP students access codes.

For students seeking a self-study AP Exam access code, please email **Pam Holden-Webbei**th your first and last name and the AP exam you seek to self-study.

2. <u>Total Registration www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/222297</u> (site ABRHS uses to process payment of AP exams)

Students with no middle name: use a period (.)

Students with documented disabilities seeking accommodations for AP Exams

The College Board Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD) office must approve a student for accommodations to take an AP exam.

Regular AP exam base price \$106.00, Reduced Rate AP exam \$69.00

AP Exam Fee Reductions / Reduced Rate AP Exam fee

Students enrolled in or eligible to participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) qualify for a \$37 per exam reduction on all 2025 AP exams.

Students still determining their eligibility should have their families submit a completed NSLP application (found <u>HERE</u>) by March 1, 2025, to ensure time for ABRSD Food Services to process the application and update the AP Coordinator by 4/1/25.

AP Exam Registration for AP classes that begin before Nov 16, 2024 (Full Year, 1st Semester, 1st or 2nd trimester, etc.) Timeline:

Sep 09, 2024: Date and Time to begin registration

Oct 31, 2024: Preferred registration completed and AP exams paid for deadline

Nov 01, 2024, LATE REGISTRATION FEE: Begin +\$10 per exam late registration fee

Nov 09, 2024 REFUND POLICY: Date by which a student can receive a Full Refund

Nov 9, 2024: If you still need to complete the Two website enrollment process, do it NOW.

Nov 09, 2024, LATE REGISTRATION FEE: Begin +\$45 per exam late registration fee

Nov 14, 2024, 11:59 PM Date and Time to end registration

Nov 15, 2024: The AP Coordinator will order May 2025 Exams for individuals who have completed the two-website enrollment process and paid.

After 11/15/24, AP late registrations and refunds can still occur until 3/7/25.

Students taking the AP Computer Science class offered in Semester Two (start date 1/23/25) will not be charged a late fee for ordering/paying for the AP exam if done by 2/1/25.

AP Exam Refunds

Only some colleges/universities accept AP Exam credit; students should inquire with Colleges / Universities directly or use the <u>AP Credit Policy Search Tool</u>.

If you decide not to take an AP Exam, it's a two-website process

- 1. Log into your **Total Registration** account and indicate that you no longer want to take the AP exam. A refund will be given via the payment method used initially <u>if a refund is due.</u>
- 2. Log into your myap.CollegeBoard.org account and indicate "no" to taking the AP exam.

If your family moves outside of the ABRSD and you have registered and paid for AP Exams, notify the AP Coordinator via email, pholdenwebber@abschools.org, with your name, the last day of school at ABRHS, and the Name and location of the school you will be attending so a transfer code can be provided to your new school AP Coordinator, which will allow you to take the AP exams at your new school.
