**Meet Dates and Times:** Tuesday, May 13 and Thursday, May 15 - Field Events 4:30pm, Running Events 6pm

**Roster Entries:** All entries will be entered using the [MileSplit OH](#) system. Late entries and changes past the deadlines will not be accepted. Please double check entries; there should be no mistakes with the entries being entered online. The meet will be seeded on Monday, May 12, 2025. **Substitutions will be allowed until 10:00am the first day of the event.** Please e-mail me substitutions if you are having trouble with MileSplit OH substitutions, but subs will not be allowed after the time stated above.


- **Entry window opens: Friday, 4/25/25 at 8:00am**
- **Entry window closes: Sunday, 5/11/25 at 5:00pm**
- **Scratch/Substitutions: None online, 10:00am on the first day the event is contested.**

**Meet Logistics**

- Coaches must arrive with the team and check in at the ticket booth. Athletes who are dressed will be admitted for free. Anyone not in uniform who is not a coach, administrator or bus driver must have a ticket or CWC Pass to be admitted. No individual school ID's will get you into the meet. The admission price is \$8 for each day.
- **Bus Parking:** Please have your buses drop off the teams at the stadium and then park along the sidewalk that runs from the stadium to the high school (similar to a football game).
- Meet packets will be available at the ticket booth on the southeast corner of the stadium .
- Implements should be weighed at the pavilion at the southwest corner stadium.
- We will have a coaches meeting at 4:15pm at the finish line with the Head Referee and Field Referee.
- Please do all scratches in the bullpen or at the event. No substitutions will be allowed **after 10:00am** on the first date that the event is contested.
- All scoring questions should be given to our CWC Official Scorer in the Press Box or to the Head Referee.
- All results will be posted [MileSplit OH](#). There will be no results packets after the meet is over.
- All pole vault verifications are enclosed **in the meet packets**.
- We will have new meet programs available to the Head Coaches on Thursday, with scratches and substitutions included for that day.

**Starting Heights:** We are following the District Policy of starting heights, along with some suggestions from coaches and AD's for the following heights:

- Girls High Jump – 4'2"
- Girls Pole Vault – 6'6"
- Boys High Jump – 5'2"
- Boys Pole Vault – 8'6"

- Your Meet Packet will be given to you upon your arrival. The packet will include the following:
  - [Coach's Uniform and Sportsmanship Verification Forms](#) (return to Matt Spellman)
  - [Pole Vault Certification Card](#) (given to the umpire at the Pole Vault event)
  - These forms can also be printed, signed and submitted to Matt Spellman in advance or before the meet using the links above.
- Do your warm-up exercises on the backstretch between events or when some lanes are not in use.
- ¼" spikes are the required length on the track, long jump, pole vault and high jump.
- Address any rulings to the Head Track and Field Referees of the CWC Meet.
- Starting blocks will be available.
- Report **ON TIME** to the correct bullpen. There will be a bullpen at the north end of the track. Listen for the call on the PA.
- Lead-off runner of the relay must have a relay card to present to the clerk in the bullpen.
- Know how your race is run. Know where your relay exchange zones are. Tongue depressors and tennis balls only are used on the track for relay starting marks. **No Chalk!! No Tape!!**
- **Camp sites will be on the southeast or east sides of the stadium, outside of the track fence.**
- Coaches and all contestants not competing MUST remain in the stands or in areas outside of the fence around the track. No rest areas or camps are permitted inside of the track. If you are not competing in high jump or pole vault events, stay away from the areas. Please observe from the stands.
- Please use available trash cans for orange peels, bottles, cans, cups, trash, etc. PLEASE!!
- You are responsible for your own equipment and valuables. Do not leave them unattended.
- Please **DO NOT WEAR SPIKES IN THE BLEACHERS!!**
- Stay away from the finish line area. Do not ask for times from officials after the races. They are instructed **NOT** to give them to you. Wait until the results are posted to the left of the Concession Stand or announced. Report suspected errors in results or scoring to the **Computer Scoring Official** at once.
- Any visible undergarment worn under the uniform top and/or bottom is now considered a foundation garment. FOUNDATION GARMENTS ARE NOT SUBJECT TO LOGO/TRADEMARK/REFERENCE OR COLOR RESTRICTIONS (Rule 4-3-1b7). Visible items worn under both the tops and the bottoms of a uniform do not have to be the same color. For additional information regarding uniforms, please refer to pages 25-26 in the [OHSAA Track and Field Coaches Manual](#).
- The concession stand will be open. Cash and credit cards are accepted.

- Restrooms are located near the concession stand.
- All lapped runners will be allowed to continue running on the inside lane or may move to an outer lane of their choice. Officials will not designate where to run.
- Be sure you do not break before passing lane markers on all break races (800, 1600, 3200, 4x800, 4x400).
- The 4x200 Relay exchange colors are red-red-yellow.
- A competitor may wear a watch but not utilize pacing functions.
- Athletes are to stay out of the school building at all times.
- **A trainer will be available on the infield near the finish line. She will have a limited supply of tape, ice, etc.**
- There will be a Coaches Hospitality Room in the ticket booth on the southwest corner of the Field House on the south end of the stadium. Snacks and water will be provided throughout the event.
