## AUTHORS GUIDELINES

(Full paper submission)

In the Proceedings of the conference “STEAM + X Approach in Education: Research, Practice and Perspectives” only original scientific papers will be included for publication.

Papers should be submitted in English language and should meet standards of contemporary English.

Papers should be one author's sheet, i.e., at least 16 pages (1800 characters per page) with 1.5 line spacing. The paper should be submitted in Microsoft Word format, page size A4, font Times New Roman, 12 pts. All pages have to be numerated (lower left corner).

The paper will be reviewed by two foreign referees.

**The Title Page** should consist of the following information: paper title (important: the title should be slightly different from the title of the paper presented at the conference), name of the author(s), institutional affiliation, place and country and ORCID number of author(s) in format: <https://orcid.org/0000-0000-0000-0000>.

The title should be concise and precise. Summary with keywords should be included below the title of the paper and above the introduction. The footnote on the title page should consist of the note of acknowledgement of the project's sponsors, as well as an e-mail address of the corresponding author.

**The Abstract** should be maximum 1400 characters long (including spaces), font Times New Roman, *italic*, 10 pt. It needs to be composed of the following elements: the importance and context of the problem, goals, sample, methods, results, conclusions with pedagogical implications.

Abstract ought not to contain references.

It should be submitted in English.

Keywords (up to five) should be presented in English.

### **Format of the Paper**

The paper should be structured in compliance with IMRAD format which is prescribed by the American Psychological Association (APA). This obliges that the papers contain the following sections: Abstract, Introduction, Method, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, References and Appendices.

The main title of the text should be written in capital bold letters.

**Data in tables** should be typed with the 1.5 line spacing, and the title of the table should be numerated and written in *italic*. The table title should be concise, short and precise. The tables should be comprehensive (without reference to the text), positioned in the main body of the text.

Tables should be created in Word or a Word compatible format. Tables from the statistical packages should be imported into Word. Numeration and title of the table should be placed above the table.

**Graphical supplements** should be sent separately, titled in capital letters, symbols in accordance with the type of the text used. Unnecessary lines and shadings should be avoided. Headings, legends and explanations that accompany the graphical supplements should be written on a separate page. Resolution of the digital images should be at least 300 dpi. The text should contain the markers of the approximate position of the given graphical supplements.

The same data should not be presented both in tables and graphically.

### **References**

All references in Serbian both in bibliography and inline should be written in Latin script, regardless of the type of the script which is used in the text and the script in which the original works (books and journals) are printed. The names of all authors which are listed in bibliography and inline should be always written in the same manner.

Last names of Serbian authors which are mentioned inline outside the brackets should be written in the script of the paper. Last names of foreign authors cited inline should be stated in original or in Serbian phonetic transcription.

If transcribed, originals should be typed in brackets, e.g.: Pijaže (Piaget, 1975). Ordering of multiple authors in brackets should be done alphabetically, not chronologically (Brodroža, 2011; Đević, 2009; Ševkušić, 2010). If the cited paper is written by two authors, the names of both authors are given in brackets (Pavlović & Šefer, 1995). If there are more than two authors, the name of first author is given and the abbreviation *et al* is added.

Bibliography list at the end of the paper gives information which is obligatory for the identification and collection of the sources. Only used references are listed. The list of bibliography at the end of the paper is given in compliance with the APA style of citation. References are given in alphabetical order by the last names of the authors. It is not necessary to numerate the references.

**References in books.** Reference should consist of last name and initials of the authors, the year of publishing, the title of the book (in italics), place of publishing and the name of the publisher.

Author, A. A. (2008). *The title of the book*. Place: Publisher.

Author, A. A. (2012). *The title of the book*. Retrieved May 18, 2000 from the World Wide Web

Author, A. A. (2010). The title of the chapter. DOI: xxxxxx Editor, A. A. (ed.) (2009). *The title of the book*. Place: Publisher.

Book chapters are cited in the following way:

Author, A. A & Author, B. B. (year). Title of the chapter. In A. Editor, B. Editor and C. Editor (ed(s).) *Title of the book* (pp. xxx-xxx). Place: Publisher.

Author, A. A & Author, B. B. (year). Title of the chapter. In A. Editor, B. Editor and C. Editor (ed(s).) *Title of the book* (pp. xxx-xxx) Place: Publisher Retrieved May 18, 2000 from the World Wide Web

Author, A. A. & Author, B. B. (year). Title of the chapter. In A. Editor, B. Editor and C. Editor (ed(s).), *Title of the book* (pp. xxx-xxx). Place: Publisher. DOI: xxxxxx

**Journal article.** The reference should contain last names of all authors with initials, the year of publishing (in brackets), the title of the article, full name of the journal (italic), volume number, issue number and DOI number: xxxxx

Author, A. A, Author, B. B. & Author C. C. (year). The title of the paper. *Title of the journal*, Volume (year), Issue number, xxx-xxx. DOI: xxxxxx

A reference which applies to the paper published online in its entirety is cited in the following way:

Author, A. A, Author, B. B., Author C. C & Author, D. D. (year). The title of the contribution

**Web Document.** The reference should consist of the name of author(s), year and title of the document (*italic*), date when the site is visited, Internet address of the site:

Degelman, D.: *APA Style Essentials*. Retrieved May 18, 2000 from the World Wide Web <http://www.vanguard.edu/psychology/apa>.

Papers that originate from the same author are given by the year in which they are published. If there are more than two authors, reference is given by the last name of the first author, but comprises last names and initials of other authors. If more papers of the same author in the same year are cited, references should contain letters *a*, *b*, *c* adjacent to the year of publishing (e.g. 2012a, 2012b).

Footnotes and abbreviations should be avoided.
